After completing your service time, you must write at a minimum, a One-Page thoughtful reflection on an experience from at least one of your service experiences. Please type your paper—12 point, Times New Roman or Arial. Your reflection should include responses to the following

- Describe your favorite service experience--Where you went, what you did, how long it took, etc.
- Who were the people that you helped and how did your service impact them. Did you know the people that you served and was that easier or harder for you to serve them? Why?
- When we serve we have a great opportunity to learn about ourselves. What did you learn about yourself?
- God is in everyone and everything that we encounter. How did you connect to God and your faith?
- Would your service be considered a Corporal or Spiritual Work of Mercy? Provide details.
- Wrap your paper up by stating why people should be of service to others, how this prepared you for Confirmation and how you'll continue to serve others as part of your discipleship for Christ.

By our baptism we are all called to service. We do this because Jesus tells us to in Matthew 25:37-40 "Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? When did we see you a stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you? When did we see you ill or in prison, and visit you?" And, the King will say to them in reply, "Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me."
