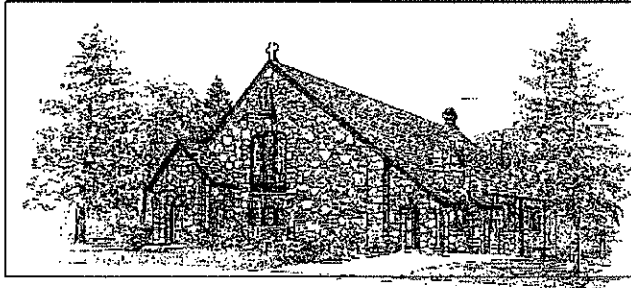

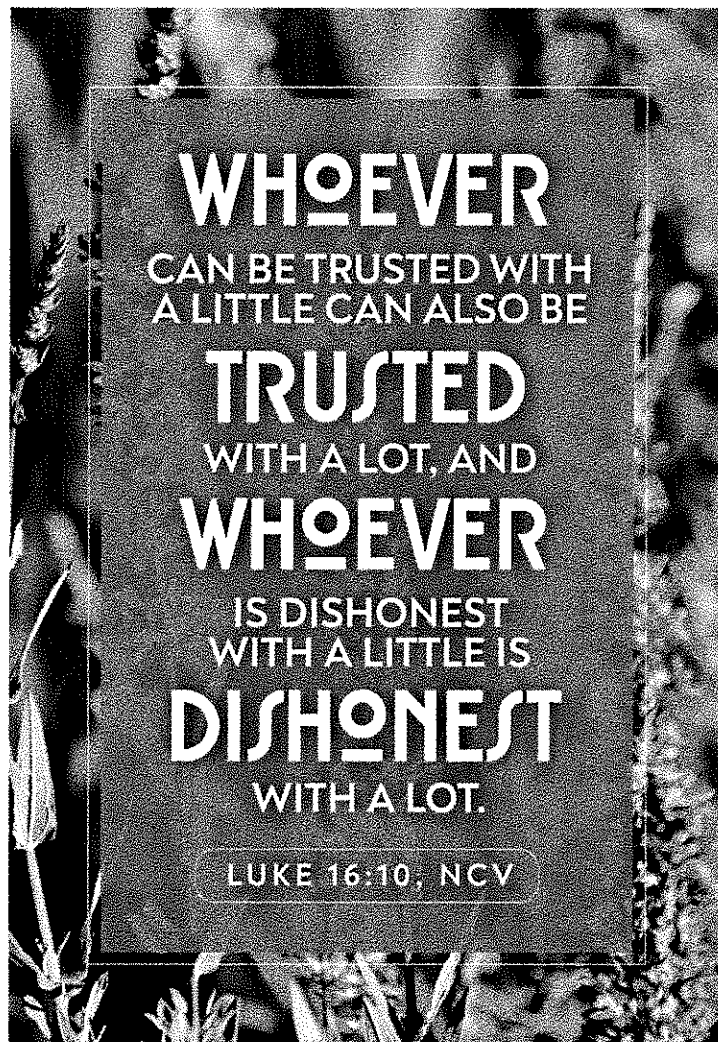
PARISH MEMBERSHIP

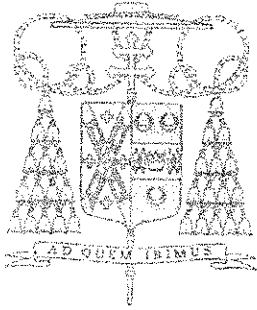

Dear friends in the Lord:

Whenever I receive letters from parishioners, no letter cheers me more than when I read how much the faithful love their priests. And as you know, most were educated and formed at our own seminary, St. Joseph's, Dunwoodie.

Our seminarians are not only the future shepherds of our flock, but they are also spiritual guides and leaders in our communities. We must be sure that they are as well prepared as possible to serve the Church in New York. And Dunwoodie is that place of formation and has been for the past 122 years. Thousands of holy, dedicated and faithful priests have been ordained over these years. It is nationally renowned, held in the highest regard by bishops from around the country. Each year, other dioceses and religious orders send their candidates to our priestly formation program.
