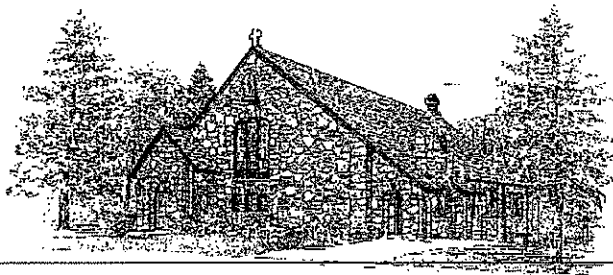

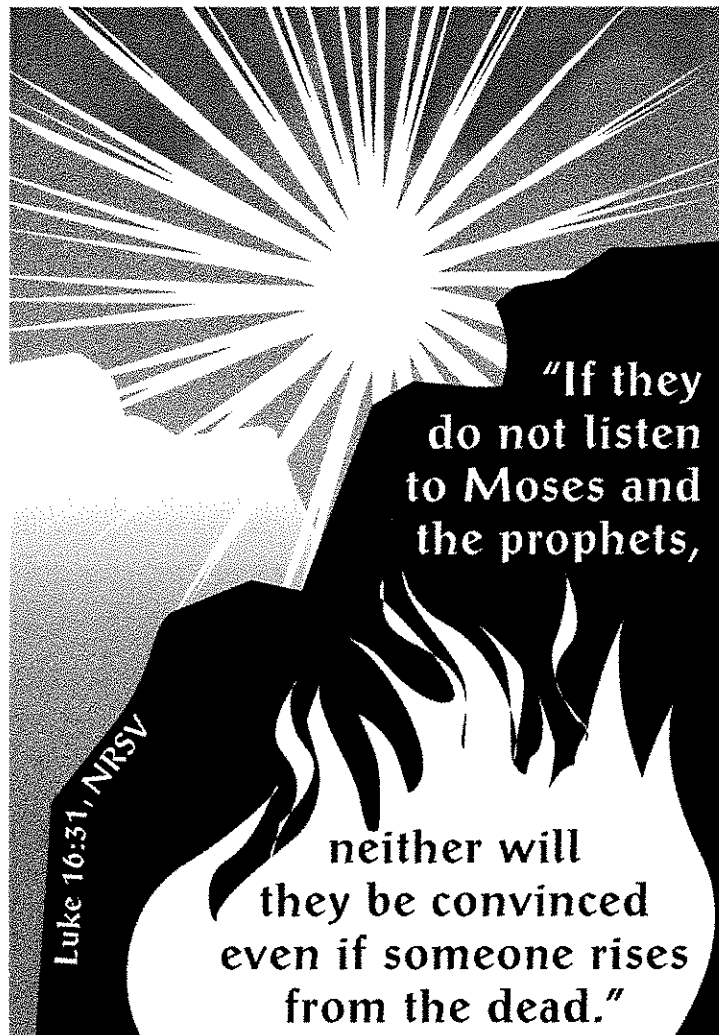
PARISH MEMBERSHIP
