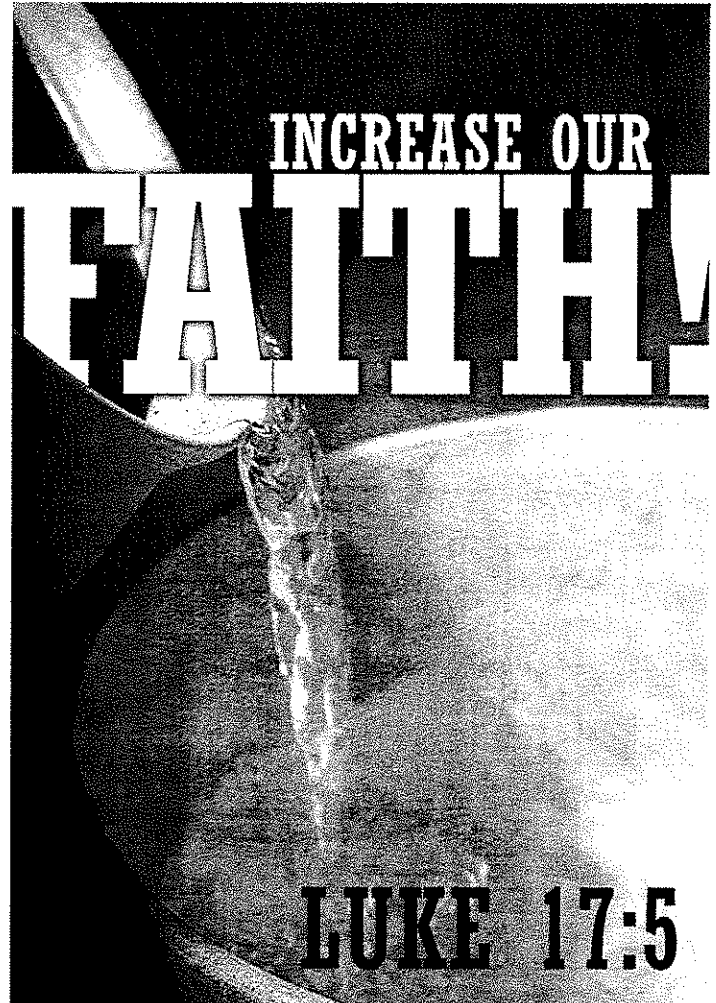
PARISH MEMBERSHIP

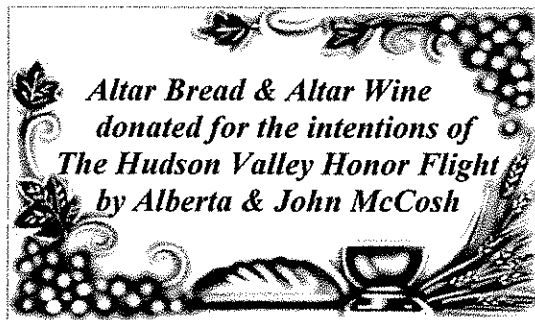
