All newcomers are welcome to Holy Rosary. Every person should be properly registered. If you move or change your address, please notify the rectory.

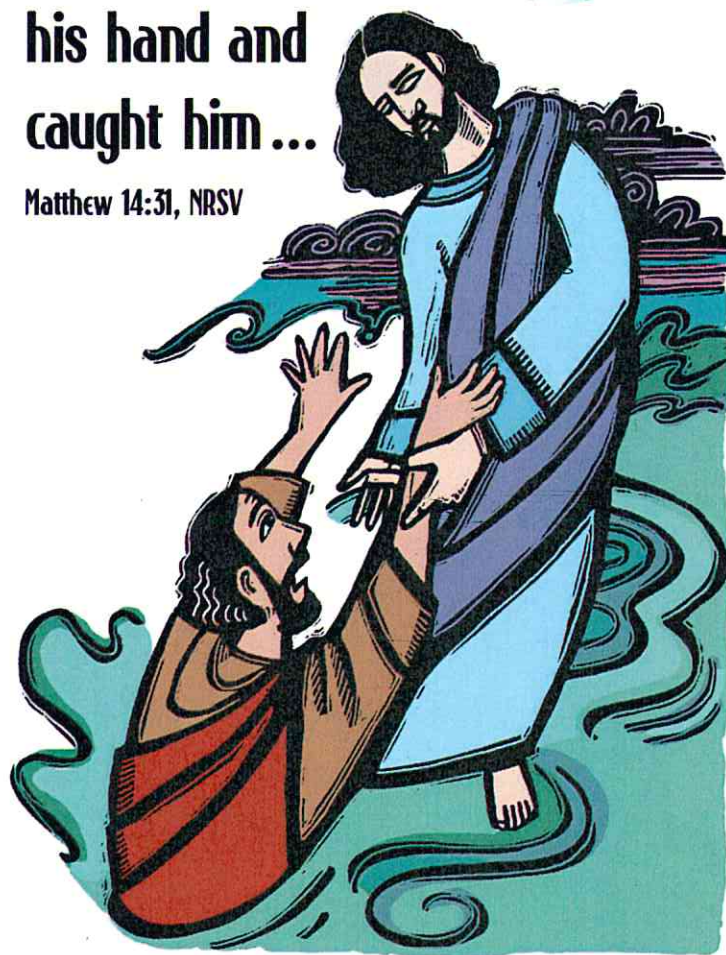

How many times in our lives have we sought some sort of sign from God of what direction to take, what decision to make? SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Maximilian Kolbe

The feast day of Saint Maximilian Kolbe is August 14th. Born in 1894 in Poland, he died at age 47 in the German death camp of Auschwitz.

When a prisoner escaped, the camp commander retaliated by ordering that 10 men be moved to an underground bunker until they starved to death. When one of those chosen voiced despair about his wife and children, Maximilian stepped forward and asked to take his place. After two weeks with no food or water, Maximilian was the only man still alive. He was given a lethal injection and died.

The man he saved survived the war, and lived to the age of 93, spending his life proclaiming that he would never forget the heroic act of love by the man who died for him.

Saint Maximilian Kolbe gave his life to save another, just as Jesus gave his life to save us. He models for us the unconditional love that God has always freely given to us. God calls us to do the same.
