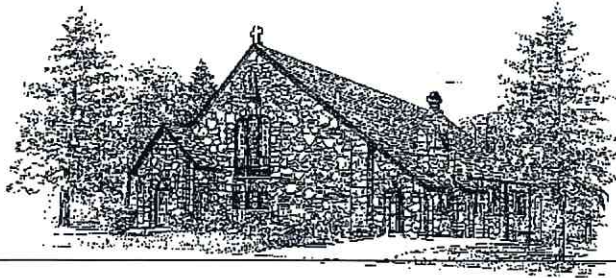

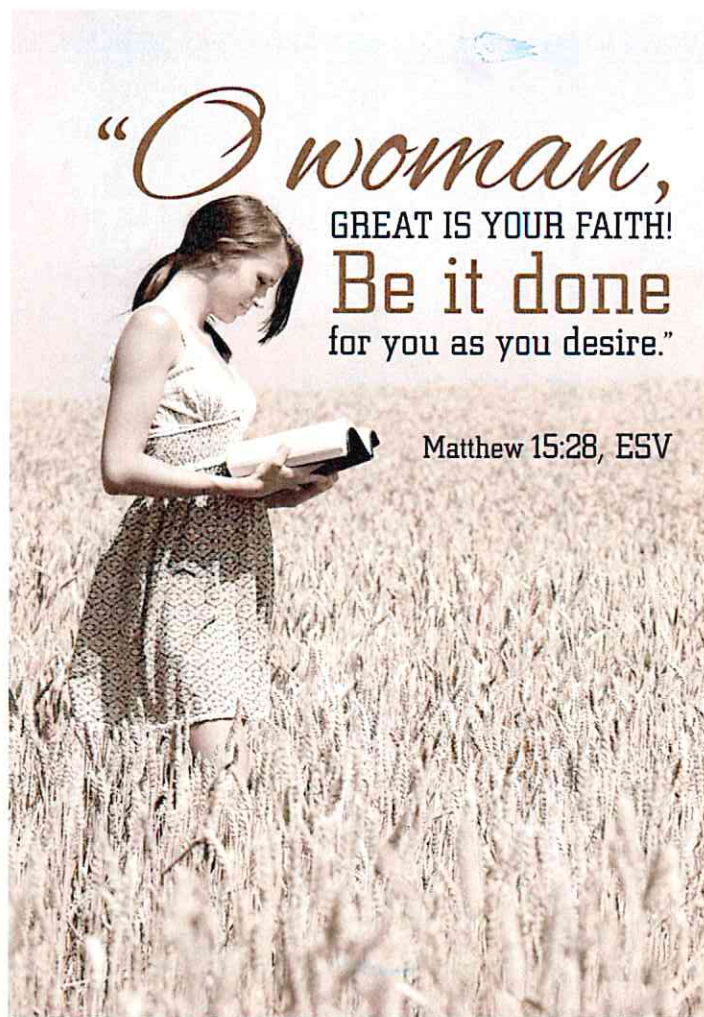
## PARISH MEMBERSHIP

### TWENTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In the Gospel, Jesus speaks to a Canaanite woman in a way that makes many feel uneasy. The woman pleads for Christ to heal her daughter, but he refuses because she is not an Israelite. Jesus explains that his ministry is only for *the lost sheep of the house of Israel*, and not for a Canaanite woman and her family. If there were a question of 'who's in and who's out?' she is plainly out.

At least, that's what was true under the old covenant. With the coming of Christ, however, that woman, once on the peripheries, is now invited to the Kingdom. Through her faith, she moves from the outside in, taking her family with her: Her daughter *was healed from that hour*.

### SAINT OF THE WEEK

#### **St. Helena**

St. Helena is largely remembered as the mother of the emperor Constantine. Her husband, a Roman general, divorced her before becoming emperor. But her son, Constantine, remained loyal to his mother. When he eventually became emperor, he elevated Helena with the title "most noble woman" of Rome.

Constantine attributed his decisive victory to a vision of the Cross. Though he did not formally become a Christian, by the Edict of Milan he granted toleration to Christianity, which quickly became the official religion of the empire. Helena embraced Christianity and used her resources to build churches and endow local shrines. Legend has it that, in a cistern near Calvary, she discovered three crosses, one of which was believed to be the True Cross on which Christ died.

St. Helena spent her final years in a humble convent in Palestine, where she died around 330.
