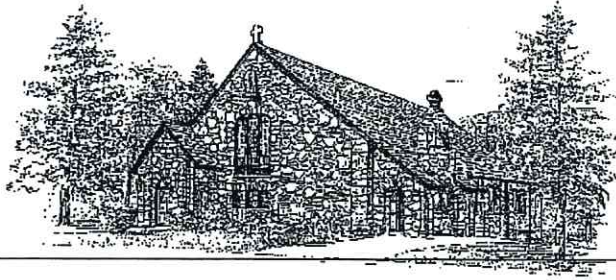

## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

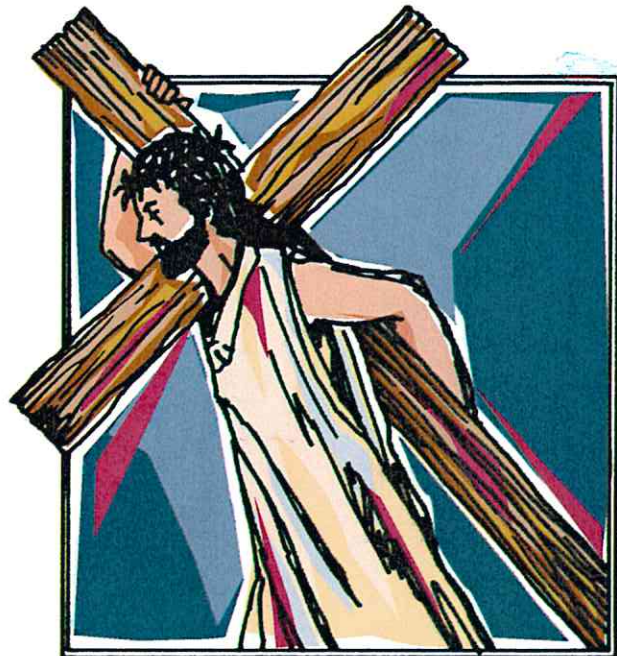

### TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today's readings discuss something rather uncomfortable: The necessity of sacrifice, of taking up our crosses to follow Christ, even when following Christ comes at great expense.

Our crosses are heavy. But Jesus calls us to take up our crosses and follow him. He gives us his body and blood as food for the journey, as we bear our sufferings and bring our imperfections to Calvary. We are invited to participate in Jesus' sacrifice on the cross by uniting our sufferings to his. In offering our very selves as a living sacrifice, Saint Paul says, we worship God and we can be transformed, becoming more holy as we are evermore united to the will of God.

### SAINT OF THE WEEK

#### **St. Aidan**

Born in the late sixth or early seventh century, probably in Scotland, Aidan was a Gaelic-speaking Celt who became a monk on the island of Iona, located off the coast of Scotland. At that time, the Celts of Ireland and Scotland were largely Christian, whereas most of the people of England still worshipped pagan gods.

According to the historian Bede, it fell to Aidan, a man who "loved to give to the poor," to Christianize the English people.

In the early 630s, Aidan became a good friend of Oswald, the king of Northumbria, who had been exiled to Iona for political reasons. While there, Oswald was converted to Christianity.

Sensing that Aidan would make a great example of a Christian, Oswald, who was returning to his throne, invited Aidan to Northumbria to carry on missionary work. Aidan traveled to England and settled in Lindisfarne, where he established a monastery. That same year, Aidan was elevated to the post of Bishop of Lindisfarne.

For the next 16 years, Aidan traveled through the Saxon villages of Northumbria, preaching the Gospel. Building churches and establishing monasteries, Aidan slowly began to convert the Saxons. To ensure that Christianity was strongly established in the area, he ransomed 12 English boys who had been enslaved and trained them for the priesthood.

Aidan died in 651 in the Northumbria and was buried in Lindisfarne.
