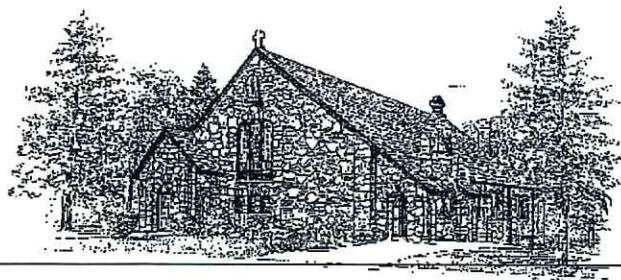

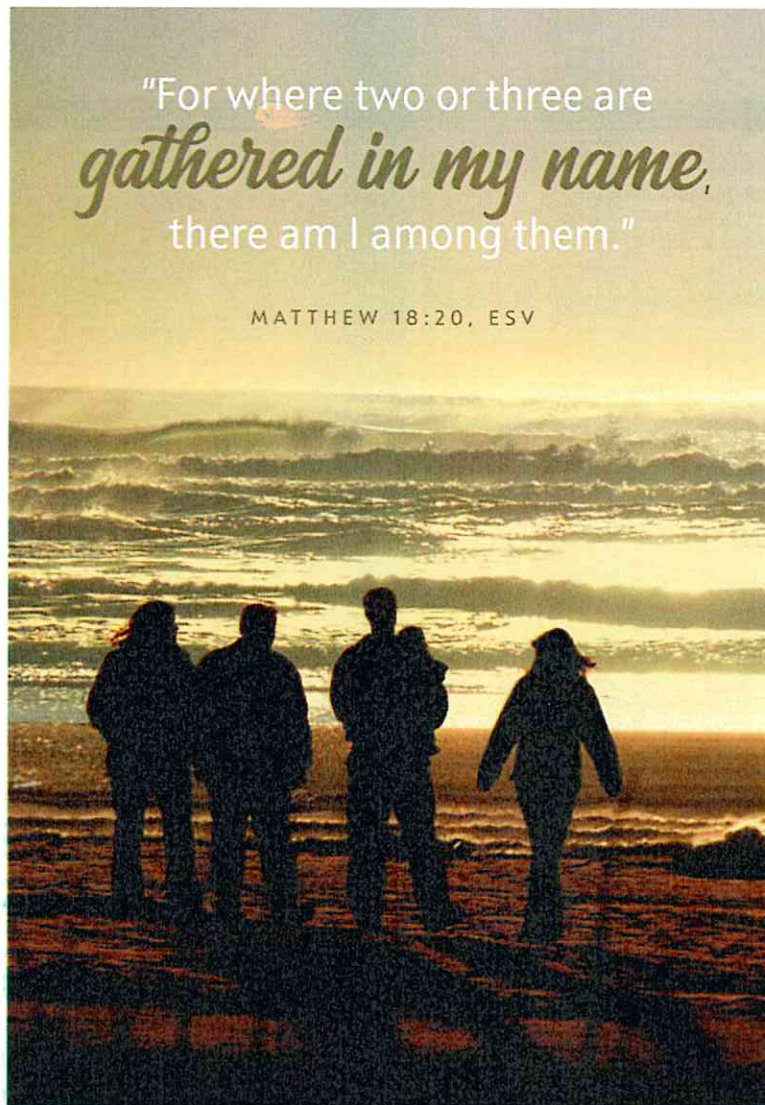
PARISH MEMBERSHIP

SAINT OF THE WEEK

September 8th - Birth of Mary

The Magnificat contains the words which were conceived in her very heart and expressed by her lips. It is her personal and spontaneous prayer to God. We are not told of her actual birth, nor are her parents mentioned in the Bible. Tradition calls them Joachim and Anne.
