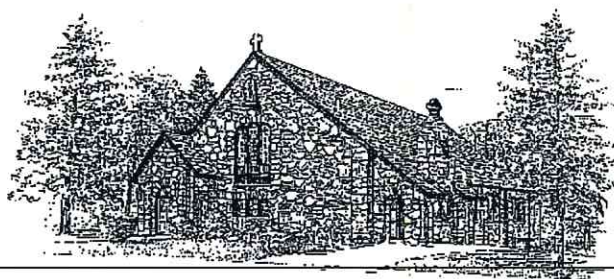

FEAST OF THE WEEK

September 14th – Triumph of the Cross

The most widely recognized sign of Christianity is the cross. It is to the Church what the flag is to the country. It is with this sign that we bless ourselves, others and various objects. Death, by crucifixion, was regarded as the most cruel form of capital punishment. What originally was a sign of punishment and death, now symbolizes abundant life. When the early Christians first began to honor the cross because of its close association to Jesus, the non-Christians rebelled. St. Paul called it an obstacle to the Jews and madness to the Greeks and Romans.
