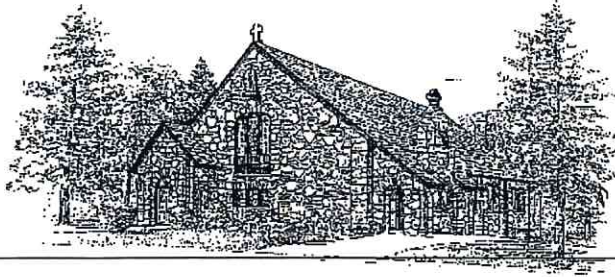

### SAINT OF THE WEEK

**Saint Vincent de Paul – September 27<sup>th</sup>**

Vincent de Paul was born in France in 1580. Although he later achieved fame for his dedication to the poor, his early life was spent attempting to escape his humble roots.

In 1605 Vincent was captured by pirates, who brought him to Tunis in Africa. He was sold into slavery and he remained a slave for two years. During this time, he prayed to God, telling Him that if his life would be spared, he would devote the rest of his life to the service of the poor.

After his eventual escape from Africa, Vincent served a church in rural France. The poverty he found there shocked him. He began to take stock of his resources, and his former connections with the wealthy and influential led him to seek their financial assistance.

As time went by, Vincent founded an order of priests, the Vincentians, who pledged to devote their lives to the spiritual and material needs of the poor.

**Prayer of St. Vincent de Paul**

Lord Jesus, you who willed to become poor, give us eyes and a heart directed toward the poor, help us to recognize you in them – in their thirst, their hunger, their loneliness, and their misfortune. Enkindle within us a spirit of simplicity, humility, and the fire of love that burned in St. Vincent de Paul. Strengthen us, so that we may contemplate you and serve you in the person of the poor, and may one day be united with you in your kingdom. Grant this through Christ, Our Lord. Amen.

### TWENTY-FIFTH SUNDAY

#### IN ORDINARY TIME

The ways of God are infinitely different from our ways. God's way of justice is radically different from our literal, juridical concept of justice. Both of our readings focus on that difference.

The reading from *Isaiah* comes from a larger section in which the prophet speaks of God's mercy in the face of the constant infidelity of the people. Justice, in human terms, demands their punishment. But, God's ways are above our ways.

The Gospel provides a parable which makes this point real to us. The story *does not* hold up the norm of human behavior.
