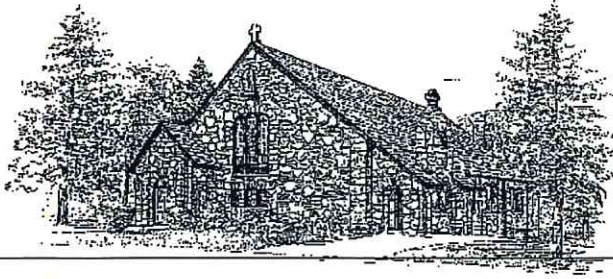

Grade 1 – 8 is offered to children of all parish families. Continuous enrollment in a Religious Education program is required for the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation.

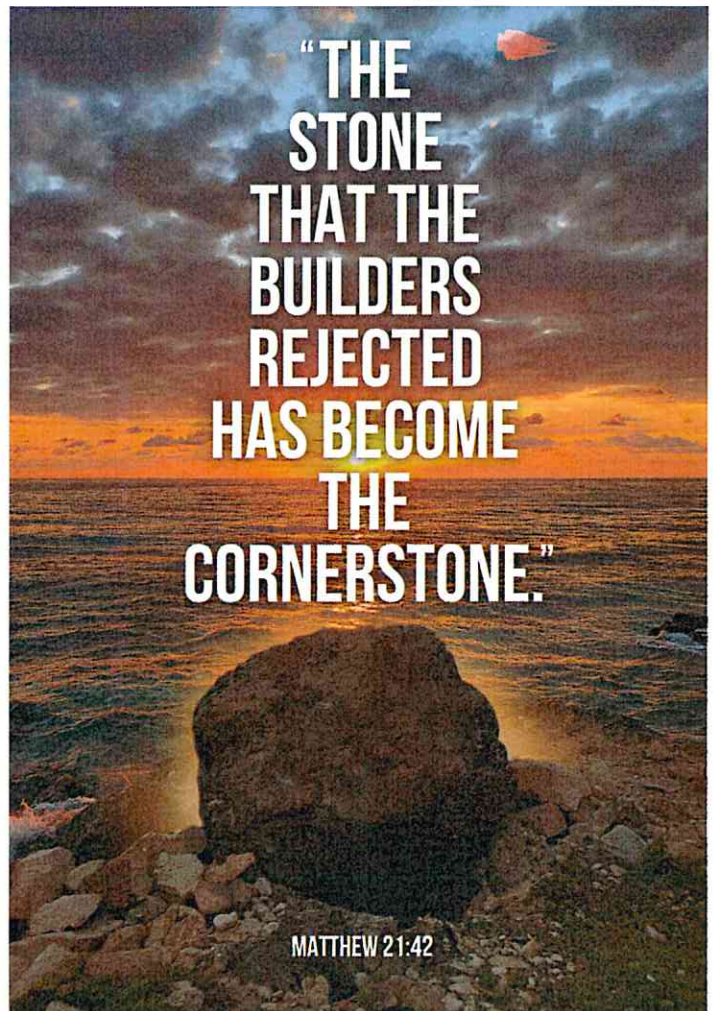

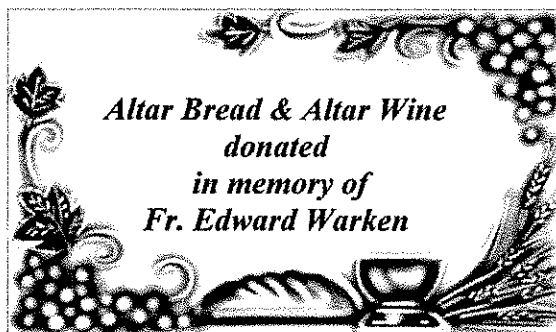

OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY

October 7th

On the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, it is important for us to consider the immense treasure of spiritual good that is found in the recitation of the Holy Rosary. In 1571, the Turks of the Ottoman Empire were defeated by the Christians at the naval battle of Lepanto. Attributing this success to the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary through the recitation of the Rosary, Pope St. Pius V instituted the feast of Our Lady of Victory. In 1716 the army of the Emperor Charles VI under Prince Eugene defeated the Turks of the Ottoman Empire near Belgrade while the Rosary was being prayed in Rome. In 1961, the name of the feast was changed to the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary.
