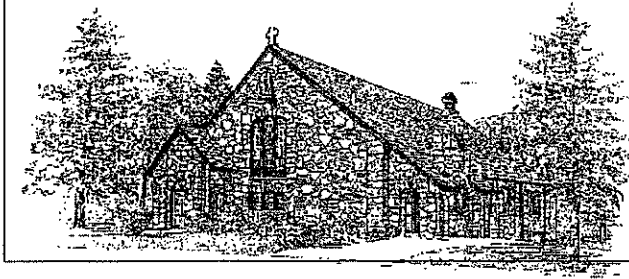

Grade 1 – 8 is offered to children of all parish families. Continuous enrollment in a Religious Education program is required for the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation.

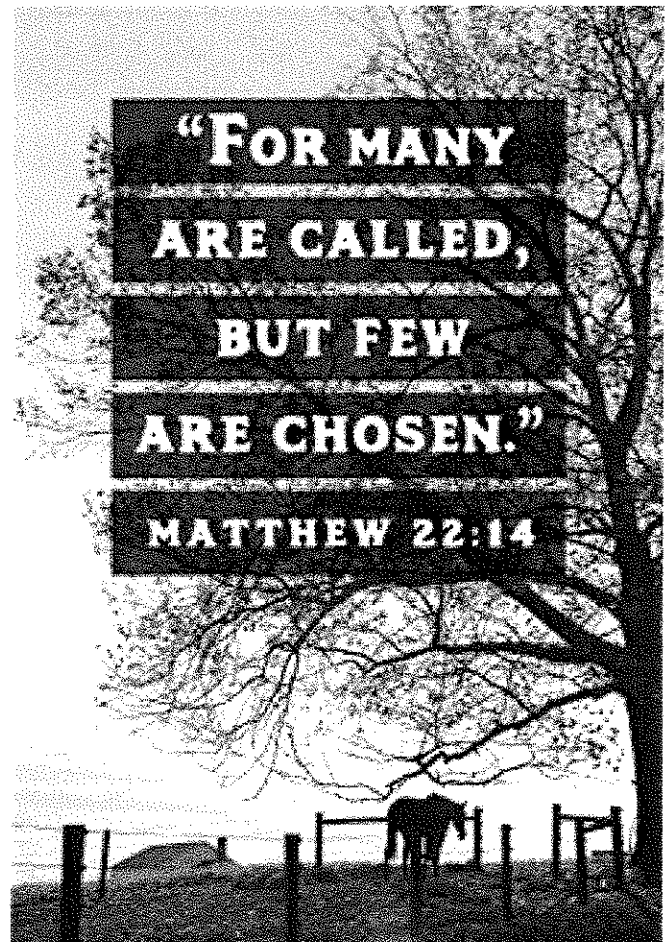

TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Both of our readings focus on the great banquet as the symbolic image of the reign of God.
Isaiah speaks of a time when we will sit at the table and enjoy the richness of God's gifts. There will be no more suffering, no violence, no evil, no tears.
Matthew takes up this symbol but applies it to the reign of God now. The focus of this parable is not the future but the invitation to share in the wedding feast now. We are called by this parable to be ready, for the banquet now – the reign of God among us with the Eucharistic banquet. Daily we choose to accept the invitation or to be too busy about other affairs.

SAINT OF THE WEEK

Ignatius of Antioch, Bishop and Martyr – Oct. 17th
Ignatius Bishop of Antioch, Syria, was arrested and ordered to be brought to Rome to die. On his way, Ignatius wrote his seven famous letters. These offer a view into the early Church at the beginning of the second century. He teaches many things about the person of Christ, the Virgin birth, Eucharist and the manner in which the Church was actually functioning.

Ignatius was killed in the Coliseum in Rome about the year 110. Ignatius leaves us not only a record of many of the beliefs and teachings of the early Church, but he was a student of Polycarp, who was a disciple of the Apostle John.
