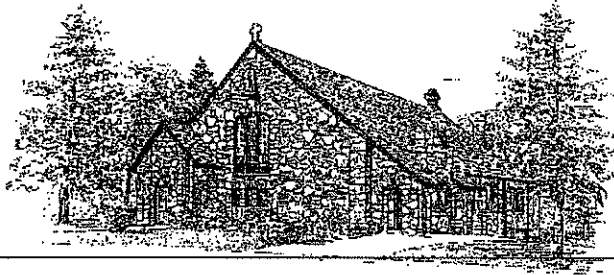

Grade 1 – 8 is offered to children of all parish families. Continuous enrollment in a Religious Education program is required for the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation.

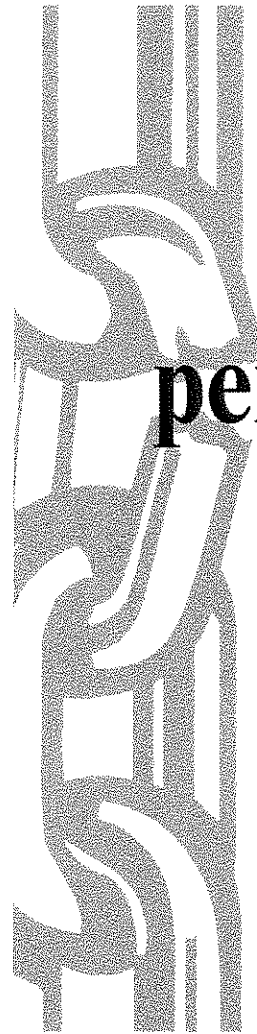
