It was suggested that Catholic schools could organize environmental education lessons using the part of the 'project' activity for Confirmation. She indicated that Catholics for Peace and Justice were working on networking ideas so parishes can advocate for sustainability locally in parish and community.

Bill indicated that he explained the way the St. Bruno Green Team operated in its home parish and commented on how the Waukesha County Environmental group was trying to bring local environmental groups together.

#### **New Business**

A discussion was held and ideas were exchanged regarding the Green Team's "Take 5" project during the Lenten season. The idea of working with St. Paul's and presenting the discussions at that venue in somewhat the same format and organization as we did at St Bruno's last year was brainstormed. Consulting the calendar indicated that the dates March 5, 12, 19, 26 and April 2 would be most appropriate for that project if St. Paul's approved. Bill and Jean volunteered to contact Mary Kral and set up the details for repeating the "Take 5" project at St Paul's for the 2017 Lenten season. Karen agreed to lead the third Sunday's discussion.

Karen agreed to take care of the notice for Electronics Recycling date scheduled for February.

The next meeting was set for Feb. 16, 2017 at 7 pm , St Bruno's School.

A closing prayer ended the meeting at 8.37.
