Updates:

- I. Ellen Knaflick – Library organization initiative
 - a. No current system for organizing the books
 - b. Initiatives to level books and organize desired – Current options are not financially feasible a search will continue to explore viable options.

 - c. Committee members agreeing that additions to the library should be added to a wish board for auction driven by teachers direction

- III. Goals:
 - a. Communication – Goal: Help identify and support programs and systems that foster frequent, consistent communication between school teachers and parents.

- b. Assessment Tools (Reading primarily) – Goal:
 - i. Current tools are inconsistent and disorganized as they are currently teacher specific, is there a common tool that can be used school wide that covers all ages
 - ii. Multiple classrooms sharing one tool and cannot use at free-will
 - iii. Assessments should occur at least quarterly and progress tracked as well as potential deficiencies identified
- c. Unity between church and school – Goal: The school committee will regularly review upcoming parish and school planned and potential events to identify opportunities to connect the parish and school in unison to enhance the outcome of each event as well as strengthen the partnership between the school and parish families.
 - i. Review annual calendar of events to identify opportunities for integration between school and parish at each monthly meeting.
