- September minutes were reviewed by Rachel Turner, unanimously approved by the committee at 6:07pm
- Principal's Notes:
 - Teacher Initiatives
 - Working on School Improvement Plan (see below)
 - Establishing initiatives and activities to support school improvement plan goals – “Wild Cat Way”
 - PBIS
 - Student Pledge – incorporates “Wild Cat Way”
 - Reinstating formal referral sheet for reporting office visits – behavioral issues, etc. (This will transition to electronic tracking version in the future)
 - School Improvement Plan: (3 goals – 1. Academic, 2. Catholic Identity, 3. Choice of the school)
 - St. Bruno choice goal: Disciplinary related – By the end of 2020-2021 academic year, St. Bruno School will experience a 40% reduction of school office referrals, compared to the 2019-2020 academic year (measured from the month of September through the end of February and then through the end of May)
 - Catholic ID goal: Each child will engage in at least 2 outreach projects in the 2019-2020 academic year. Students will understand how their project affects the community and each project will incorporate at least one act of mercy.
 - Academic goal: by the end of the 2019-2020 academic year, St. Bruno School will observe a 3% improvement (increase) in reading/language arts and math testing scores, measured by standard assessments (compared to previous year).
 - Family Handbook – In progress, distribution date has not been set yet
 - Power School – This week new power school login information will be distributed. Teachers will update grade information and homework assignments by the end of this week. Homework is not graded, it is marked as “collected” and the students and/or teachers will check it for accuracy.
