### Minutes of Meeting

Tuesday, September 22, 2015

Father George opened the meeting at 7:00pm with a prayer.

**Open Forum:** Chick O'Leary provided the Council with information concerning the erection of the cell tower in the church parking lot. A lengthy discussion was held regarding the layout of the tower and the risks to adjoining neighbors and school children. Further information will be obtained and shared with the Council.

Also presented by Chick was information on the program FORMED.org in which St. Eugene Parish is now a participant. Lighthouse Media has rolled out an internet-based program which has all the audios from Lighthouse Media, as well as various other enrichment programs, movies, etc. The cost of this program would be \$140/month for the parish and would be available for all parishioners to subscribe by merely calling the rectory and obtaining the parish access code for St. Eugene, after which they would be able to go online and create an account individually for approximately \$10/month. Hopefully, reports would be available showing parishioner participation. The Parish Council approved our participation and support of this adult enrichment program.
