Dear St Theresa Families,

We miss you. We miss our students. We miss our everyday routines that connect us as a community and as a St. Theresa family. We are so eager to see our students back in our classroom, learning and growing. At this time, we are still planning to welcome students back to school both virtually and on campus on August 12th. We understand that while some families will elect to opt-in to Distance Learning due to health concerns, despite the increased safety measures on campus, many families stated in our survey that Distance Learning is not supportable in their family. Therefore, in the event that schools are mandated to begin the school year 100% virtually in August, our St. Theresa School Board approved a delayed start of the school year until September 8th, so we may begin on campus and virtually for families who opt-in. ***This delayed start would only be considered if we would be mandated by local officials or the Archdiocese to start 100% virtually with no on-campus instruction.***

When we do return to campus, The attached First Look at our Reopening Plan shares the many ways we have improved facilities, implemented social distancing protocols and enhanced procedures to ensure our students and staff stay safe and healthy while on campus. The plan also shares the robust nature of our new and improved Distance Learning Plan.
