In order to safeguard the health of our students and staff, St. Theresa Catholic School is utilizing a program, CLEARED4SCHOOL, to assist with daily monitoring for COVID-19 symptoms.

St. Theresa Catholic School has arranged for each parent to receive an email with login information (email address) and Temporary Password and link to access the program along with detailed instructions for accessing CLEARED4SCHOOL.

***IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE THE EMAIL AS EXPECTED, CHECK YOUR JUNK/SPAM AS THE EMAIL MAY BE AT THAT LOCATION. The email will be from noreply@farforward.com**

It is important to complete the daily screening questions BEFORE you leave for school each day, in order to avoid an unnecessary drive to the school or a delay in carpool drop off. Health screens must be completed by 7:15 each school day.

****Failure to complete the questionnaire will result in a delay for student drop-off. Parents will be asked to proceed to the end of the carpool line to complete the questionnaire.***

We encourage everyone to maintain a working thermometer at home so that temperatures can be checked each morning and as needed.

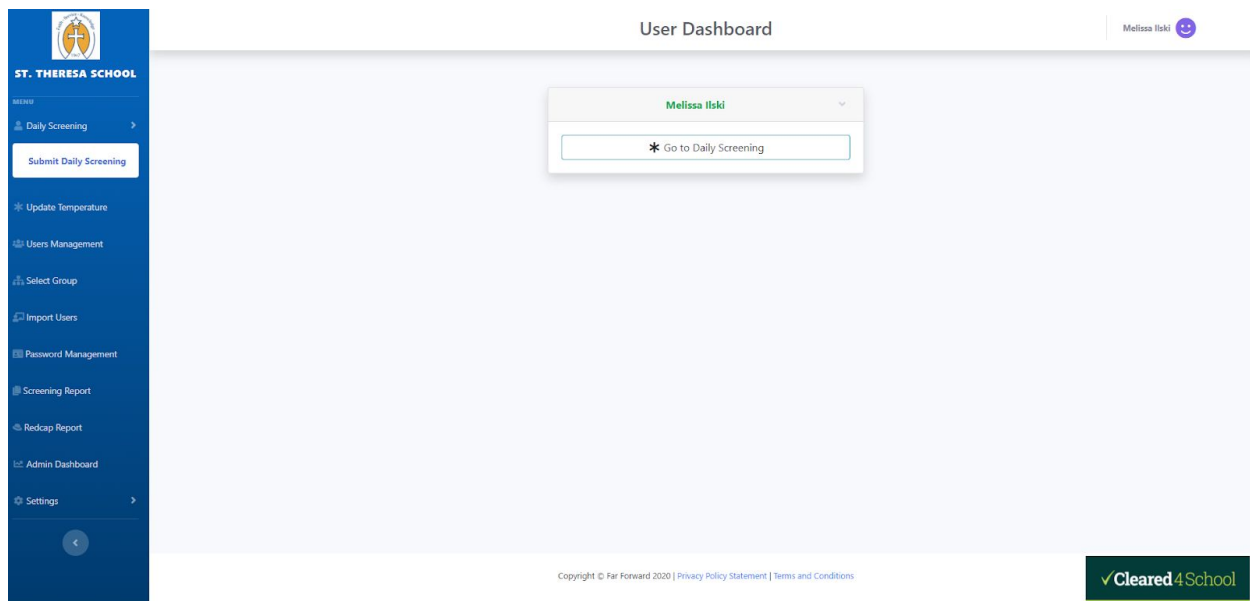

Please see the following screenshots for tips to complete the screener....

Step 1: You will receive an email from Cleared4School with your User ID (email address) and a temporary password and a link to register your account (or your student's account.) The first time you log in, you will be asked to set your permanent password (can be any length, any characters or

numbers, can have caps or no caps), and you will be asked to read and acknowledge the privacy policy and service agreement information (remember to check the box after you read these) and submit. Then you will proceed to the daily screening questions.

Step 2: Click on the **Daily Screening** tab on the left and then click on **Submit Daily Screening** and then **Go to Daily Screener** to complete health screening questions.



Step 3: Answer symptom questions, measure temperature, then submit. As you answer each question, it will automatically prompt you to the next question. DO NOT click NEXT or it will skip a question and you/your child will not be cleared for school.

Step 4b: In the event that the staff/student is NOT CLEARED for school, then instructions will be provided to contact Nurse Horne. Users will NOT be cleared IF they identify ANY COVID symptoms. ONLY check symptoms that are NEW OR UNUSUAL.

- In the event that a student is NOT CLEARED due to symptoms present, the user will be disabled for further use, until the Nurse and/or Administration can review and assess symptoms for return to school.
