Tips for Parents During Red Ribbon Week

Use Red Ribbon Week as an opportunity to continue talking to your kids about drug safety. For younger students let them know that they should only take medicine from a trusted adult. The school nurse, a doctor, a parent, and NEVER from a stranger or another child.

Did you know.....Children of parents who talk to their teens regularly about drugs are 42% less likely to use drugs than those who don't, yet only a quarter of teens report having these conversations.

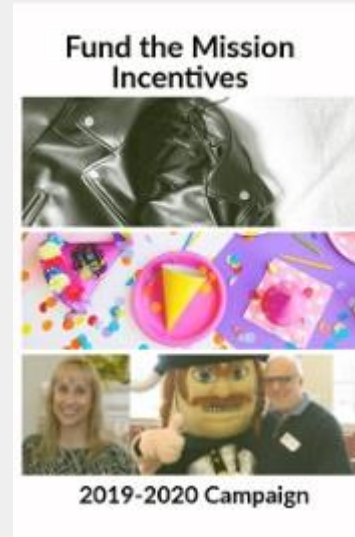
We would like to thank the parents, teacher, staff, alumni, and parishioners, that have responded.
