School Information

On Monday, October 7, 2019, St. Theresa students are invited to participate in a \$1 non-uniform dress day that will support "The Rose." The Rose reduces deaths from breast cancer by providing access to screening, diagnostics, and treatment services to any woman regardless of her ability to pay. The Rose addresses any barrier that might keep a woman from caring for her own needs.



In order to be eligible for this non-uniform dress day, students are asked to bring a minimum of a \$1 donation which should be given to their homeroom teacher. All donations should come in a sealed envelope with your child's name and homeroom teacher listed on the envelope. Students may wear pink shirts, shorts, jeans and shoes! Students who are unable to participate in this non-uniform dress day should come to school in their regular school uniform. All proceeds will benefit The Rose. The yearbook staff will review all photos, and determine final yearbook content. We cannot guarantee that all submissions will be used.

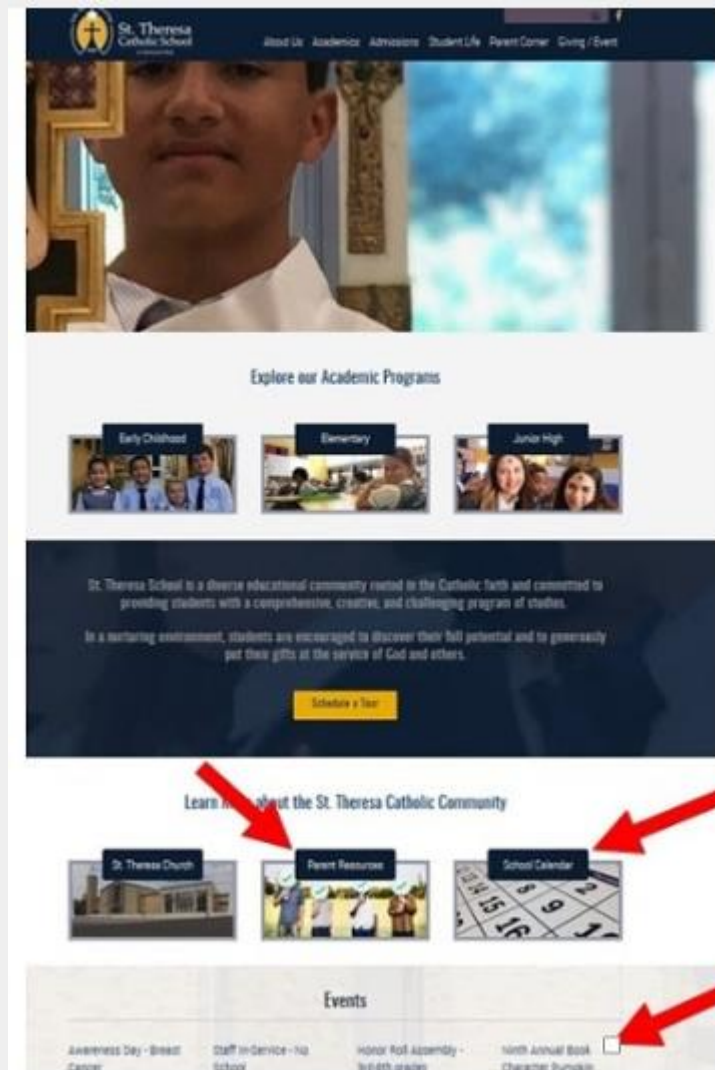
