Counselor's Corner



As we head into the Thanksgiving holiday next week all classes will be reflecting on what we are thankful for, and how taking time each day to reflect on the positives in life can benefit everything we do. Students will think of areas which are challenges and find positives about difficult situations. By focusing on positives students develop strengths that will help them succeed. This week's mindfulness exercise is thinking about what we are unthankful for.

(1) Think of something for which you are thankful, then think of something you are unthankful. It might be a job, relationship, health condition, financial situation, etc. The idea is that it is something that you tend to react to with anger, resentment, resistance, rejection, or frustration.

(2) Now, think of all the things that are good about it.

This may take some work but if you focus on the positives we can develop strengths and see this in a new light. For example, being stuck in traffic every day. Instead of seeing this as a problem we can focus on the time it gives us to listen to our favorite podcast, music, or talking with family before the busy day.
