## Awareness Day Monday, November 4



On Monday, Nov. 4, 2019, St. Theresa students are invited to participate in a \$1 non-uniform dress day that will support "Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation." Type 1 diabetes is an autoimmune disease that strikes both children and adults suddenly. It has nothing to do with
