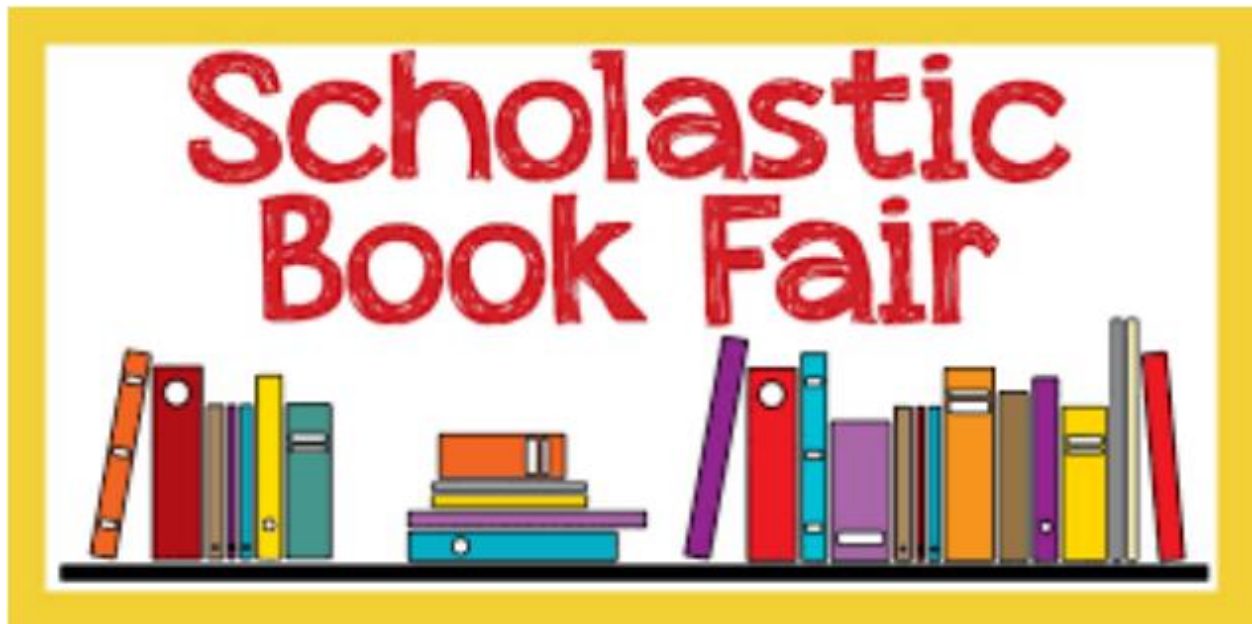
The items can be purchased and shipped directly to St. Theresa.

The students were engaged with problem solving this week and discovered problem solving models and pros and cons lists. Every grade worked hard thinking about ways to be proactive problem solvers. This next week we will be discussing self-esteem and how to help it grow even in challenging situations.

This week's mindfulness activity will require one object with interesting colors or texture from nature.

1. Choose a natural object from within your immediate environment and focus on watching it for a minute or two. This could be a flower or an insect, or even the clouds or the moon.
 2. Don't do anything except notice the thing you are looking at. Simply relax into watching for as long as your concentration allows.
 3. Look at this object as if you are seeing it for the first time.
 4. Visually explore every aspect of its formation, and allow yourself to be completely focused on this object.
 5. Reflect on its purpose in the natural world.
