How to Practice 5 4 3 2 1 Ask your child to name the following:

- 5 things that you can SEE in the room
- 4 things that you can FEEL/TOUCH right now
- 3 things that you can HEAR
- 2 things that you can SMELL now
- 1 thing that you can TASTE

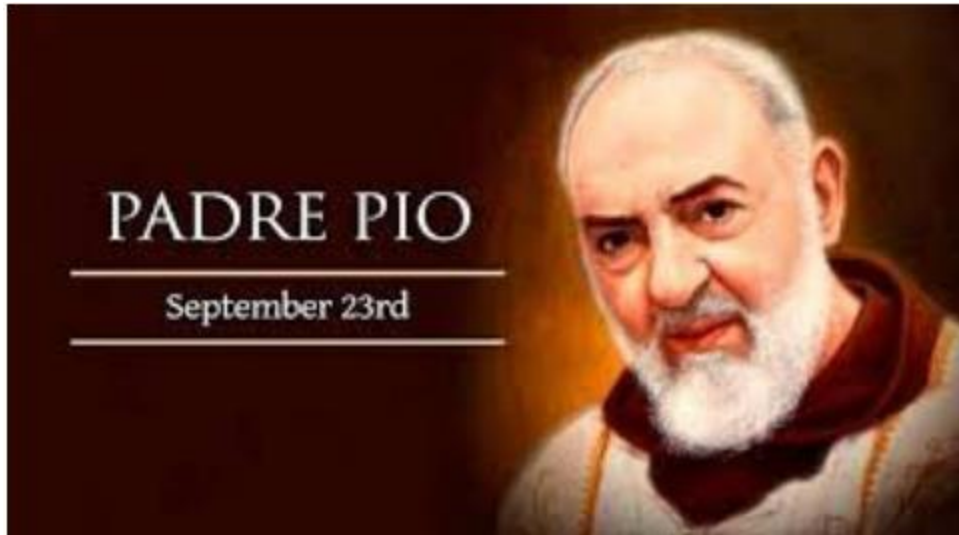

On-Campus Reminders

Cleared4School Health Screener

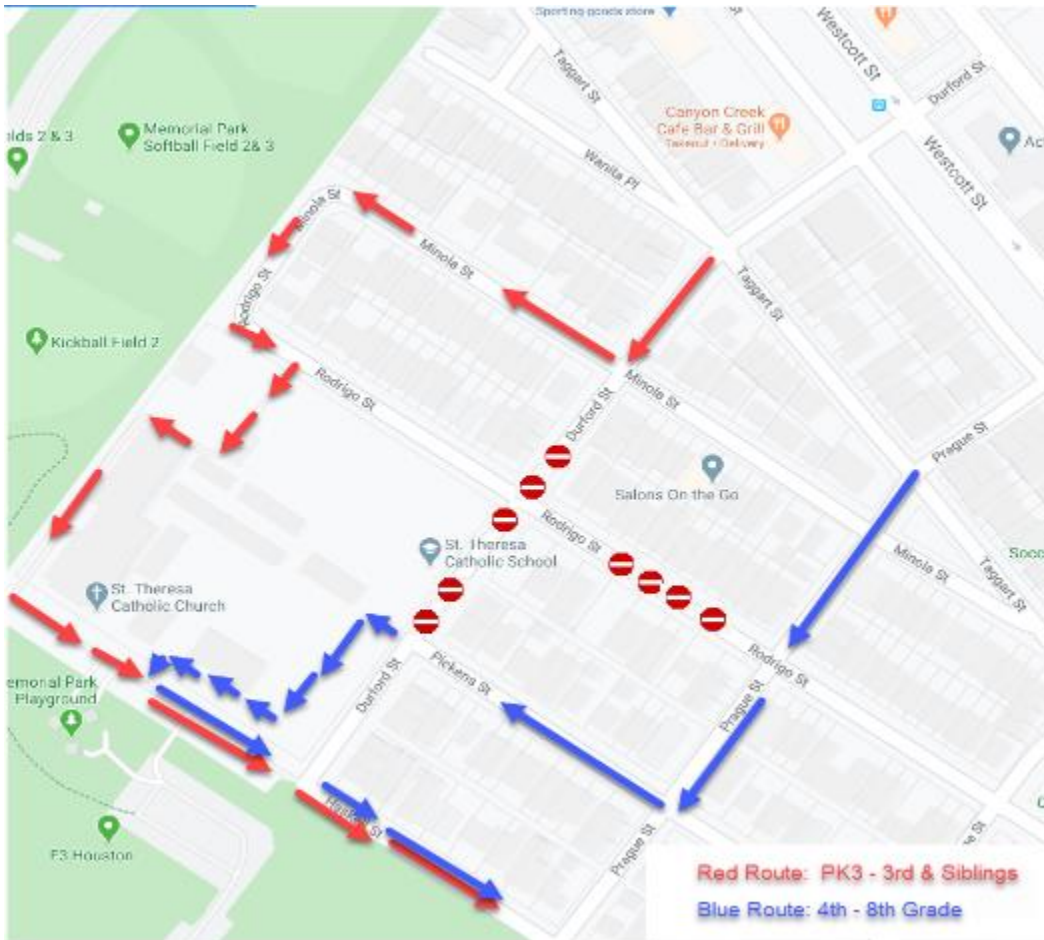
- **Selecting ANY symptoms on the health screener will result in NOT CLEARED FOR SCHOOL and the student will not be permitted on campus without a doctor's clearance**
- **ONLY select a symptom if it is NEW or UNUSUAL, do NOT select a symptom if it is related to regular allergies or known pre-existing conditions for your child**
 - Must be completed in the morning, before 7:15AM.
 - Technical difficulties cannot be addressed in carpool- contact Mrs. Lastovica if you are having login difficulty r.lastovica@sttheresa.cc
 - Car tags must be in window for morning **Arrival AND Dismissal**

New Carpool Routes

- **The new carpool routes were a huge success yesterday! Cars were fully loaded and the line cleared on both routes within 10 minutes!!** There is no need to arrive early for such a quick dismissal process. Please try to stay off the neighborhood streets before carpool begins, as it makes very narrow streets unnecessarily congested.
- Please be sure to follow all new routes, in the directions posted- neighborhood streets are very narrow and it's difficult to accommodate two way traffic
 - **Reminder: 1st-3rd has been moved to the Red Route**
- Please allow space for neighbors to exit their homes as needed during carpool
- Remember to notify your child's homeroom teacher and Mayra Reyes m.reyes@sttheresa.cc of any carpool changes prior to 2:45PM

- Early Pickup ends at 2:30PM for all routes
