- Virtual / Suggestion Box Comments
 - No feedback provided.
 - Suggestion made that the Virtual Suggestion Box be added to the Parish App.

- Fall Festival Update from Angie
 - Good results so far on the revenues generated versus the expenses for the event.
 The sponsorship donations have been key in the high revenue total.
 - More volunteers signed up this year than last year's event.
 - Ensure Department of Public Health regulations to be enforced for all volunteers in the food cooking and serving area.
- Capital Campaign Update
 - Now in the Public Phase of the Campaign (10/22-23 Kick Off)
 - o Currently at \$1,868,690 vs the goal of \$2.5M (stretch goal of \$3.0M)
 - 766 mailings to parishioners (825 registered parishioners both Spanish and English);
 some returned due to incorrect addresses.
 - 2nd collection will be taken once per month at the Spanish speaking Mass (1:30pm Sunday) in support of the Capital Campaign
- Community Prayer Service
 - Gathering at Founders Park of area church groups; approximately 30 minute session with prayers and intentions for the community and nation. Local church leaders each shared petitions.
 - ~25 St. Martin de Porres Parishioners attended the event with ~80 people in attendance
 - Overall, low turnout in the community, but positive response for future community prayer services

- Parish Energy
 - o Recent low attendance and collection numbers at overall Mass times
 - Faith Formation There is a disconnect between parents and parish life.
 Communication issues to be addressed by Kevin and Michele.
 - o Need to re-energize parish life; future ideas to be discussed
