Reports

- Diocesan Capital Campaign: Encountering Christ
 - Efforts underway to have a good start to the Campaign
- Financial Update
 - We paid \$450,000.00 to the principal and save us a total of \$344,000.00 interest for the duration of the loan term. Our new balance for the St. Dymphna Center loan is \$829k
 - April Diocese will refinance all loans to market interest rate
- Chapel security
 - A generous donor will pay for the stained glass windows in the chapel, the new front doors, and security camera for the safety of the adorers.
- Education Center
 - Adding a library room with materials where people can come visit and check material out
- Vocation
 - Parish is looking to form a Vocation committee to pray for increase in Vocation
 - People can sign up on the Website to take the Chalice home to pray
- Fall Festival Update
 - Earned \$90,000 from the Fall Festival, was a very good Festival
 - Next year's goal is \$100,000

Old Business

- Feedback on Quarterly Ministry Leader (QML) Meeting
 - Received Patron Saints for each ministry to enable a Liturgical calendar to be created
- Adoration Scheduling/Sub Request
 - Working through final solution
- Childcare during Mass
 - Continue to review this as a potential opportunity
