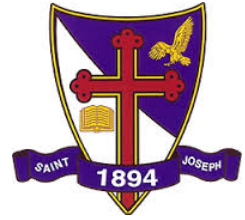


St. Joseph Catholic High School School Profile 2019

St. Joseph Catholic High School is a college preparatory, co-educational school. St. Joseph Catholic School System provides a Catholic environment for spiritual faith formation and educational excellence. Qualified students are enrolled without regard to race, gender, religious affiliation, ethnic, or national origin. Students are eligible to attend St. Joseph Catholic School unless there is a specific educational or emotional need that cannot be met. The school system was founded in 1894, and expanded to include freshman and sophomore high school classes in 1993. In 1998, St. Joseph Catholic High School graduated its first senior class. The secondary campus in Bryan, Texas serves students in grades sixth through twelve. The high school maintains an enrollment of approximately 90 students which helps facilitate a small student-to-teacher ratio. St. Joseph consistently maintains a 100% graduation rate.
