Eagle Fans and Visiting Spectators,

While prioritizing the health and safety of all student-athletes, coaches, fans and officials, we have given great thought as to how we will allow spectators at the Emmanuel Glockzin Athletic Complex for Football games.

We are comfortable with the amount of space and wide variety of viewing opportunities for spectators at the complex. Thus, we will not institute a capacity limit for Football games and tickets will be purchased upon arrival. Spectators will have the following areas to watch the game:

- 1) The bleachers – which are marked off every other row to maintain social distancing.
- 2) Outside of the endzone nearest the softball field in a horseshoe shape to each side's 5-yard line to maintain distance from the teams. Fans must sit at least 10 yards from field.
- 3) The surrounding fence areas.
- 4) From your vehicle.

All spectators are encouraged to bring their own seats as we cannot guarantee spots in the bleachers. All persons at the complex must wear masks when entering/exiting the facility, as well as any time they are up and about (i.e. trip to concession, restroom, etc.) and in areas it is not possible to social distance.

Parents bringing young children to the game are the sole persons responsible for their child(ren). St. Joseph personnel will not supervise activities behind the bleachers.

There is no online ticketing option available. *Please bring exact cash, if possible. Admission is \$7 for adults and \$3 for children.*

The areas extending past the 5-yard lines are off limits. Fans who choose to sit on the field must give the teams space.

We look forward to a great year of athletics at St. Joseph Catholic School and wish all of our visiting teams and fans well throughout their year. With your support of these initiatives, we will be able to provide our student-athletes a memorable experience while abiding by current health standards.
