The most common reason for making an Act of Spiritual Communion is when a person cannot attend Mass.

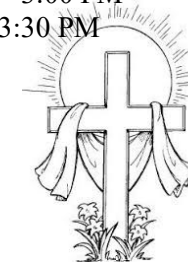

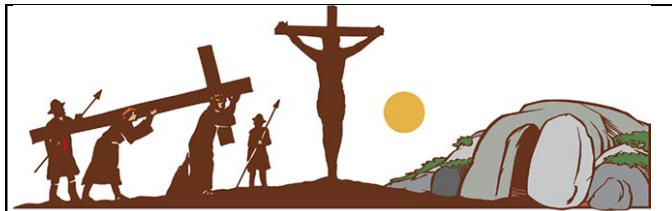
