Planting & Decoration Regulations

1. On monument lots, only annual flowers may be planted at the head in a space equal to the length of the monument by 16 inches in width; or, if there is no monument, in a space equal to that which the monument would normally occupy. In no case may the bed of flowers exceed 16 inches in width. No trees, bushes or perennial plantings are allowed.

2. Wooden, plastic, concrete or other similar receptacles containing plant material are not allowed.

3. Potted plants in pots not exceeding 10 inches in diameter, artificial flowers and wreaths are permitted to be placed on lots 7 days prior to, but will be removed immediately after the 8th day following the days listed:

Palm Sunday	Labor Day
Easter Sunday	All Saints Day
Mother's Day	Veteran's Day
Father's Day	Thanksgiving Day
Memorial Day	Christmas Day
July 4th	Anniversary Day

4. Cut Flowers are permitted when placed in an approved (recessed) metal container directly in front of the monument or in the space in which the monument would normally occupy.

5. Pall/Winter decorations will be removed as soon after March 1st as the weather permits if Cemetery Maintenance personnel are unable to complete the task according to rule #3 above.

6. Flags are permitted on graves only on Memorial Day, Independence Day and Veterans Day as agreed upon with the American Legion or VFW.

7. Under no circumstances are glass, plastic, ceramic, metal, or otherwise breakable and/or dangerous objects permitted to be placed on or near grave sites.

8. All objects shall be removed which violate the above regulations or, when in the judgment of the Cemetery Maintenance personnel, their appearance and condition warrant removal.

Many people visit the cemetery each year. Because the cemetery is open to the public, it is impossible to control the activity of every visitor, but it is the duty of the Cemetery Committee along with the Parish Council to provide a safe and respectful Cemetery for all.

No Work on monuments or graves is to be done without prior permission from the Parish Office.

CEMETERY PLOTS

CREMATIONS – Allowed two (2) cremations per plot at least 12” – 24” deep.

To bury cremations; one (1) at head and one (1) at foot of grave.

Allowed one (1) casket with one (1) cremation. At the discretion of the Church *if no more graves available*, can bury two (2) cremations in grave with casket at least 12” deep.

Headstone should have names of persons buried in that plot. If no room on stone, a plaque should be placed on base of headstone.

PLOT MEASUREMENTS:

4 feet wide x 10 feet long.

This gives enough room to put a 2-foot-wide headstone per plot or 4 foot wide headstone for double plot.
