### Notes from the Parish Administrator

We have had some major expenses this past couple of weeks. We have replaced an A/C unit in the vestibule which cost \$10,972. The water heater in the CFC building ruptured on Monday evening. Replacement for the 120 gallon commercial electric tank required to service the 18 lavatories in the building cost \$11,128. Our Improvement Funds account is able to cover some of these costs. I am asking parishioners to please make contributions to the Improvement Fund monthly. Thank you.

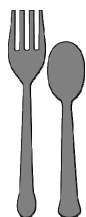
