## *It's been awhile since I went to Confession*

The Sacrament of Penance is not a test about doing something the right way. It's a moment of God's forgiveness and healing. You can't make a mistake. You simply tell the priest that it's been awhile and you're not sure how to do it. He needs to hear from you at least one sin. And that you're sorry for it. Then he and God take it from there. If you remember the Act of Contrition (in any language), you say it. If not, there are leaflets outside the Penance Room with a whole collection of possible prayers you can read. Pick one before you go in.
