

Hello All:

All Masses will be in the Church. Henceforth, our Masses are open to the public with these restrictions:

1. The maximum occupancy is 500 people. This is strictly enforced. Please arrive early as the doors will be locked about 10 minutes prior to mass starting. This is necessary to allow time to get people seated 6 feet apart and maintain headcount.
2. Please park on the East parking lot. Only the East Entrance door to the Church will be unlocked to allow entry. This is necessary to keep a count of the amount of people entering the building. All doors will be allowed for exit, however please make sure the door closes all the way when you exit.
3. All attendees are required to wear masks. Every person must wear a mask – regardless of age.
4. Please wash or sanitize your hands prior to mass.
5. Please keep a minimum distance of 6 feet between you and your neighbor. Families may sit together with 6-foot distancing from the next family or person.
6. During Communion, you must receive the Eucharist by hand only with your mask on. After the Body of Christ is in your hand, please step to the side and remove your mask with your free hand and consume the Eucharist and proceed to your seat.
7. If you are able to assist in cleaning and sanitizing the Church please look for Karen Rachal at the end of Mass or email sjm@sjmtx.com.
8. If you are able to volunteer as a minister, an usher – to direct people where to sit or go for private prayer (etc.), or to help with the headcount, please contact Karen Rachal or email sjm@sjmtx.com.
9. If anyone has a fever, dry cough, shortness of breath, or any symptoms of the Coronavirus, please demonstrate your Christian charity by staying home and following CDC guidelines.

Other things to note... If you are over the age of 65 or have a health condition that compromises your immune system, please consider staying home and watching our mass on our Facebook page ♦ <http://www.facebook.com/sjmccc> . Also, people with small children who are unable to wear a mask or sit for an extended period of time should restrict themselves to watching our livestream as well. Please note the cry room will be inaccessible at this time.
