Eucharistic Prayer	Lam 3:41	“Let us lift up our hearts and hands to God in heaven”	Lift up your hearts. We lift them up to the Lord.
SANCTUS	Rev 4:8	“the four living creatures... never cease to sing, ‘Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come!’”	Holy, Holy, Holy Lord God of hosts.
Eucharistic Prayer II	Jn 6:49-51	“Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and they died. This is the bread which comes down from heaven, that a man may eat of it and not die. I am the living bread which came down from heaven”	so that they may become for us the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ.
Memorial Acclamation	1 Cor 11:26	“For as often as you eat this bread and drink the chalice, you proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes.”	When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim your Death, O Lord, until you come again.
Final Doxology	Rom 11:36	“For from him [God] and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory for ever. Amen.”	Through him, and with him, and in him, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honour is yours, for ever and ever.
Sign of Peace	Jn 14:27	“Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you.”	Lord Jesus Christ, who said to your Apostles: Peace I leave you, my peace I give you;
Communion	Jn 1:29	“Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes	Behold the Lamb of God,

		away the sin of the world.”	behold him who takes away the sins of the world.
Communion	Lk 7:6-7	“...the centurion sent friends to tell [Jesus], ‘Lord, do not trouble yourself, for I am not worthy to have you enter under my roof. Therefore, I did not consider myself worthy to come to you; but say the word and let my servant be healed.’”	Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.
