

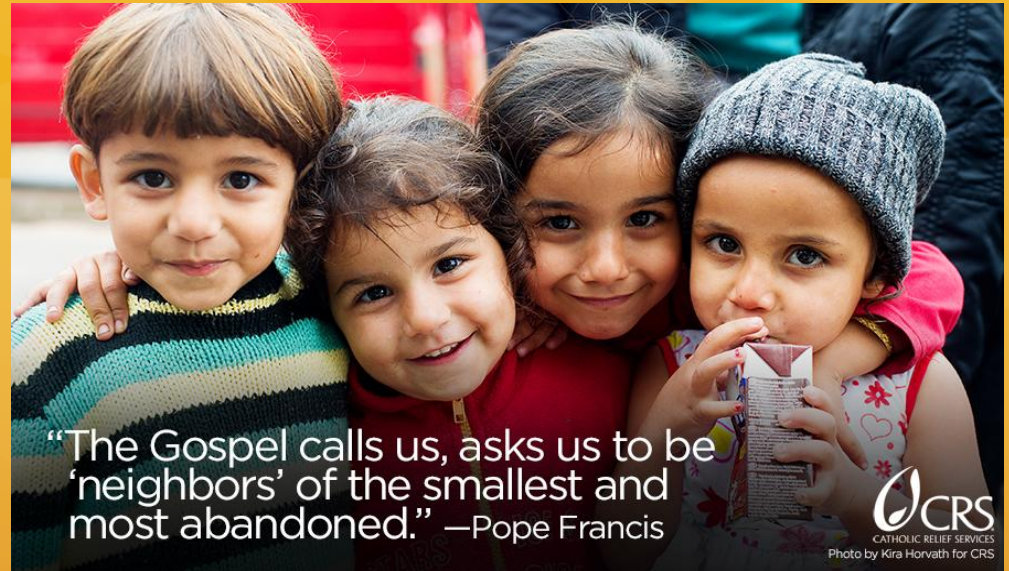
Connecting Kids to Justice
