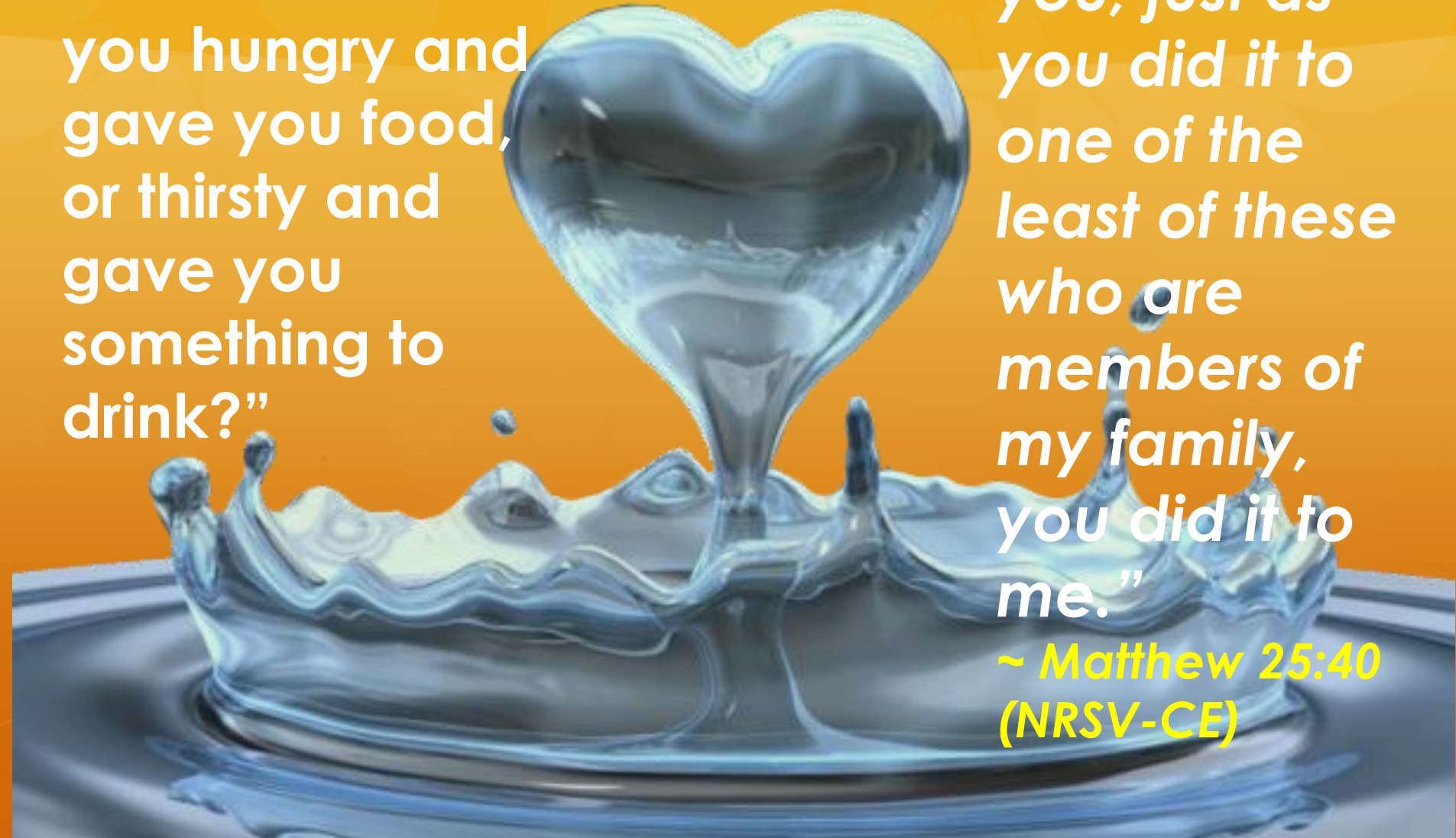
Love your neighbor!
