### **CREMATION, FUNERALS AND BURIALS**

In recent years cremation has become a common practice for many Catholics. But the faithful should know that the Church has standards that should be followed when cremating the deceased.

Firstly, it's always preferable to have the funeral Mass in the presence of the body before cremation. We believe in the resurrection of the dead and the sacredness of the human body as well. The Mass of Christian Burial in the presence of the body reaffirms this belief. So please consider this before making plans for your final rest.

Once cremation occurs it's strictly forbidden to repose the remains in a family home or be strewn and scattered over a body of water or land. In fact, it is wrong and sinful to do this. Cremated remains are still human remains and should be buried or reposed in a cemetery, preferably a Catholic one that has been previously blessed. If the cemetery has not been blessed, Catholic clergy should accompany the cremated remains to the place of reposition for a proper Christian burial with the blessing of the grounds.

Finally, may I suggest that you inform a trusted family member or friend of your plans to have a Mass of Christian Burial in your parish church, a Catholic cemetery chapel, or, at the very least, a funeral home service in the presence of the Catholic clergy. These wishes should be put in writing and made a part of your immediate last effects to be honored by that person. By our baptism we have a right to a Mass of Christian Burial or a service in a funeral home in the presence of Catholic clergy. Sincerely, Fr. Palatucci

**CONCERNS AND SUGGESTIONS ANSWERED-** Over the next several weeks I will do my best to answer the many concerns and suggestions that have been brought to my attention. Thank you for all of them. Some of them are quite good and some of them would be impossible to do. But at least I'm confident that you're concerned about your parish, caring deeply to be involved in it. Thank you for that!

**Altar rails at St. John-** Highly improbable. A parish cannot just add them without a reasonable need. From my understanding, first I must present my reasons along with an architectural design to the Liturgical Office of Archdiocese of New York. They must agree to it and then present their findings to the archbishop who has the final say regarding all liturgical renovations in parishes. Adding altar rails is not like adding new lighting or painting walls. It's a liturgical renovation. Protocols need to be followed.

The biggest hinderance with adding an altar rail are the way the stairs and sanctuary are designed. The sanctuary is curved and raised. An altar rail may not fit correctly. I also don't think an altar rail would be safe. If some people wish to receive communion kneeling, how is the priest to distribute communion if there's so little room to do so? It would pose a serious safety issue. The priest would have to distribute communion while side-stepping on the first step. Since each step is about a foot wide and curves around the sanctuary, that could pose a hazardous situation as he holds Blessed Sacrament. The rail would need to be set at least two feet away from the first set of stairs to be ground level, taking up too much room between the first set of pews and the rail. The space in the front of the sanctuary is needed for caskets when funerals take place.

Finally, an altar rail that fits the aesthetic of the sanctuary would be rather expensive. Our parish church is beautiful as it is. Would the rail add or subtract from that beauty? I think it would subtract. The final option is a complete renovation of the sanctuary by bringing it down to ground level, as it was many years ago. That's not financially realistic for many years, at the very least.

**St. Michael image at St. John baptismal font-** Not liturgically practical. What make better sense is either an image of St. John the Baptist or the Lord's baptism in the Jordan. This is something I've considered previously. I would like to do that at some point.
