How to apply for Lifeteen Voucher Program

- 1. Service must be approved in advance.
- 2. Teen submits a Voucher Service Request completely filled out. (Available Online https://stjosephscharlton.com/lifeteen-program Please Print and Complete Form)
- 3. Life Teen Director or Youth Minister approves and records Service Request.
- 4. Teen brings form to Community Service project.
- 5. Teen submits the completed form to Lifeteen Director, who requests the Voucher Unit from Bank Committee.

Terms and Conditions

- Teens must be Active Members of the Life Teen Community to be eligible to participate in this program.
- Vouchers are issued in denominations of one voucher unit per hour of Community Service.
- Teens are limited to earning thirty (30) voucher units per term.
- Vouchers should be used before the start of the next Lifeteen year. They can roll over, up to one year.
- Vouchers cannot be transferred to another person without the written consent of the Life Teen director.
- No voucher may be requested for more than three (10) credits. For example; Vacation Bible School will not exceed 10 credits earned.
- The Community Service hours <u>must be approved in advance</u> by the Life Teen director or Youth Minister, who shall assign a unit value to the service. Once assigned a value, service cannot be awarded for more units than was assigned.
- Service Requests that originate from an individual (ex. Residential yard work) must submit to CORI checks if they are requesting Community Service at their place of residence.
- Community Service shall be defined as work done for the parish or another civic or religious organization such as babysitting at a parish event, visiting the elderly in a nursing home, or volunteering as a helper in a food pantry or homeless shelter. It does not include activities in conjunction with a school or the fund-raising activities of another civic organization. (Examples include NJHS. STUCO, Honor Societies)
- Active Members The Life Teen Director or Youth Minister shall define what an Active Member is in terms of attendance, participation, and any other criteria.
