### **A BRIEF SUMMARY OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING, MARCH 6**

Those attending were Fr. Mario, Kathy Konen, Rey Esparza, Jim Krautscheid, and Theresa Flinn. Not Present: Amey Trujillo, Bev McDonald and Alejandra Garcia.

- \* The council talked about the use of the kitchen. It needs to be reorganized, drawers labeled, and a list of what needs to be done posted for those using the kitchen. Things are hard to find and items are disappearing. Theresa Flinn said there is a list of responsibilities posted in the kitchen, but will redo it.
- \* A committee is being formed to hire a new DRE. Theresa and Kathy Konen will serve on it.
- \* Kathy said we need to be more vigilant about getting people to sign up for church cleaning. Very few weekends have volunteers to clean. Kathy and Rey Esparza will encourage parishioners at the Masses, and Confirmation students should be encouraged. In addition to church cleaning, Fr. Mario said it's the usher's job to pick up the church after Mass and put chairs away.
- \* Theresa said she had a complaint from a parishioner about the lack of respect at Mass. People shake hands and visit people in the pew on the way up to receive Communion, and there is a lot of talking in the church before and after Mass when people are trying to pray. Fr. Mario will address it at Mass.
- \* Angel Lopez is working on improving the sound system in the church.
- \* Jim Krautscheid brought up enlarging the church by removing the wall between the church and hall, and building a new hall. Discussion followed, including looking into selling some of the land. Kathy said she would talk to Bob Konen to get some ideas, but did not suggest selling any land at this time.
