WHY DO I HAVE TO CONFESS MY SINS TO A PRIEST?

Some people say that they don't need to confess to a man. They say they can tell God they are sorry and he will forgive them, anywhere, any time.

Actually, that's true if you are only looking to be forgiven. But there is more to Confession (or Reconciliation) than being forgiven. If we are really sorry, we need to change, to stop sinning.

Anything is a sin if it hurts others. Most people don't think about others, so they keep on sinning. Confession forces us to take a look at our lives and see who our acts are effecting. The priest is a counselor who can explain why we are wrong and how to change. He's not there to judge or punish us. He's there to diagnose the problem and suggest a cure. He can explain things and even tell you if you're not doing anything wrong. The penance is a small step towards changing our lives. We don't have to change our lives right away, but we do need to change. The Sacrament gives us the strength to make the changes.
