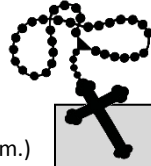

St. Kateri Tekakwitha

CELEBRATE SAINT KATERI TEKAKWITHA: Please join us on Saturday, July 13, from 11 a.m. to noon at St. Mary Parish, 360 Signal Peak Road in White Swan to celebrate Saint Kateri Tekakwitha and on Sunday, July 14, from 11 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. for a celebration and picnic to honor the 150th anniversary of the reconstruction of the Ahtanum St. Joseph Mission Chapel. The Mission, founded in 1852, is at 17740 Ahtanum Road, Yakima. The restored Chapel was dedicated in 1871. Jake Finkbonner, whose miraculous cure at age 5 was the second miracle leading to the canonization of Saint Kateri Tekakwitha, will be present for both celebrations along with his family to share his story.
