CATHOLIC CHARITIES VOLUNTEER SERVICES: *Have an hour to give back?*

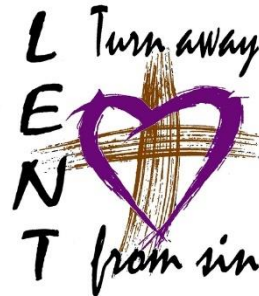

DIRECTIVES FROM BISHOP TYSON IN RESPONSE TO THE GROWING NUMBER OF CASES OF THE CORONAVIRUS:

1. If you are sick or feel you are getting sick, stay at home and do NOT attend Mass. Missing Mass due to illness is not sinful; it is prudent and shows care for your brothers and sisters. Do set aside time at home to pray for the needs of the Church, the world, your family, friends, and community, and yourself.
2. During Mass, at the Our Father, please do not hold hands. Keep them folded in prayer, or outstretched slightly, palms up, in an attitude of prayer and petition. At the Sign of Peace, simply say, "Peace be with you," instead of offering your hand to your neighbors.
3. During Communion, we will refrain from offering the Precious Blood from the chalice at this time. The Eucharist will only be offered in your hand, rather than on your tongue. Form a throne to receive Our Lord with one hand placed under the other. When the minister says, "The Body of Christ" and places the host in your hand, bow your head slightly, say "Amen," and use the bottom hand to reverently place the host in your mouth and consume the Precious Body of Our Lord.
4. You will notice that we have drained the holy water in the church, until further notice. Please simply bless yourself with the sign of the cross as you enter and exit the church. Any priest or deacon will be happy to bless water in vessels you bring for you to take Holy Water home to use.
5. Please practice respiratory etiquette and good health hygiene with these recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control: bit.ly/3cBSaac

Con un aumento de la atención al coronavirus en todo el mundo, deseamos asegurarles que nuestro equipo continúa monitoreando la situación. Sin ánimo de alarmarles, creemos que es prudente recordarles nuestras precauciones para la salud ante cualquier brote de enfermedad.

1. Si está enfermo o siente que se está enfermado, permanezca en casa y NO asista a misa. Perderse de la misa debido a una enfermedad no es un pecado; es prudente y demuestra que le importan sus hermanos y hermanas. Reserve tiempo en casa para orar por las necesidades de la Iglesia, del mundo, de su familia, de sus amigos, de la comunidad, y de usted mismo.
2. Durante la misa, en el Padre Nuestro, por favor no se tomen de la mano. Manténgalas dobladas en oración, o ligeramente extendidas, las palmas hacia arriba, en una actitud de oración y petición. En el saludo de la paz, simplemente diga: "La paz esté con ustedes," en lugar de ofrecer su mano a sus vecinos.
3. Durante la Comunión, nos abstendremos de ofrecer la Preciosa Sangre de Cristo del cáliz. La Eucaristía será ofrecida solamente en la mano, en vez de en la lengua. Formar un trono para recibir a Nuestro Señor con una mano colocada debajo de la otra. Cuando el ministro diga: "El Cuerpo de Cristo" y coloca al anfitrión en tu mano, inclina ligeramente la cabeza, diga "Amén," y use la mano inferior para colocar reverentemente la hostia en su boca y consuma el Precioso Cuerpo de Nuestro Señor.
4. Notará que hemos vaciado el agua bendita de todas las fuentes en la iglesia hasta nuevo aviso. Favor de simplemente bendecirse con la señal de la cruz al entrar y salir de la iglesia. Cualquier sacerdote o diácono puede bendecir el agua en recipientes para que lleve Agua Bendita a casa.
5. Por favor tenga la bondad de cubrirse al toser o estornudar y cumpla con las recomendaciones de los Centros para el Control de Enfermedades en: bit.ly/3cBSaac
