FAITH FORMATION: Faith Formation is going to start (tentatively) the second week of October. - † **September 27** – RCIA Mass, 3:00 p.m. Seven catechumens will receive the Sacraments of Initiation.
- † **October 4 and 11** - SPANISH CONFIRMATION, 4:00 p.m. (Because of class size there will be 2 Masses).
- † **October 12 and 14** - ENGLISH FIRST COMMUNION, 6:30 p.m. (Also divided into two Masses).
- † **SPANISH FIRST COMMUNION** will take place in November or December. Date to be determined.

Please note: Because of our limited capacity these Masses are not open to the public. However, they will be live streamed for family and friends at home. Pray for all of our youth who are receiving their sacraments, that they remain strong in their commitment during these challenging times.

MAGNIFICAT

Normally, we teach Magnificat in a classroom setting in Kennewick, Wenatchee, and Yakima. This year Magnificat classes will be done Virtual through ZOOM. English Magnificat classes will be on Tuesday evening and Thursday evening from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. and the second part of the class will be on Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. with Fr. - † Weddings and Quinceaneras: Make arrangements with Fr. Mario. All events must follow the pandemic guidelines. Capacity: 30
