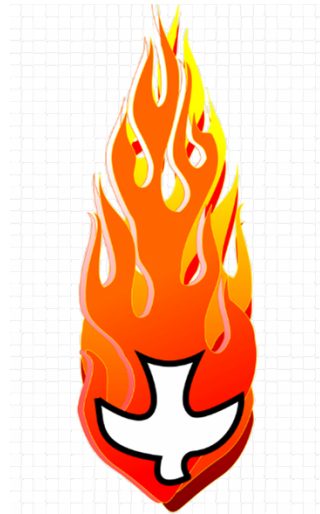

**IF YOU HAVE SCHEDULED A WEDDING OR QUINCEANERA ON OUR CALENDAR, CHECK OUR WEBSITE TO MAKE SURE YOU ARE INDEED ON IT.** That is always good to do, but especially since we had so many cancellations and re-scheduled events during the pandemic.

### UPDATE FROM THE DIOCESE ON COVID-19 PROCEDURES:

There will be no changes in our celebrations of the Mass until at least July 1. This means following Phase 3 guidance for religious services, including **50 percent occupancy limits for indoor Masses; the wearing of masks; and sanitizing of church facilities after services have concluded.** Communion will continue to be distributed in the hand only, and only under the species of bread. The dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains in effect.

Parishes that have been requesting signups in advance for Masses are encouraged to continue to do so, particularly if the process has been helpful to ensure that occupancy limits aren't exceeded and parishioners have equal opportunities to attend. (We will not require sign ups in advance, as long as we do not exceed our 50% capacity. However, we do ask you to sign in when you come to Mass.)

## ***A New Wind..... Reflection by Scott Hahn***

The giving of the Spirit to the new people of God crowns the mighty acts of the Father in salvation history. The Jewish feast of Pentecost called all devout Jews to Jerusalem to celebrate their birth as God's chosen people in the covenant Law given to Moses at Sinai (see [Leviticus 23:15–21](#); [Deuteronomy 16:9–11](#)).

In today's First Reading, the mysteries prefigured in that feast are fulfilled in the pouring out of the Spirit on Mary and the Apostles (see [Acts 1:14](#)). The Spirit seals the new law and new covenant brought by Jesus, written not on stone tablets but on the hearts of believers, as the prophets promised (see [Jeremiah 31:31–34](#); [2 Corinthians 3:2–8](#); [Romans 8:2](#)).

The Spirit is revealed as the life-giving breath of the Father, the Wisdom by which He made all things, as we sing in today's Psalm. In the beginning, the Spirit came as a "mighty wind" sweeping over the face of the earth (see [Genesis 1:2](#)). And in the new creation of Pentecost, the Spirit again comes as "a strong, driving wind" to renew the face of the earth. As God fashioned the first man out of dust and filled him with His Spirit (see [Genesis 2:7](#)), in today's Gospel we see the New Adam become a life-giving Spirit, breathing new life into the Apostles (see [1 Corinthians 15:45, 47](#)).

Like a river of living water, for all ages He will pour out His Spirit on His body, the Church, as we hear in today's Epistle (see also [John 7:37–39](#)). We receive that Spirit in the sacraments, being made a "new creation" in Baptism (see [2 Corinthians 5:17](#); [Galatians 6:15](#)).

Drinking of the one Spirit in the Eucharist (see [1 Corinthians 10:4](#)), we are the first fruits of a new humanity—fashioned from out of every nation under heaven, with no distinctions of wealth or language or race, a people born of the Spirit.
