August 21—Feast of ST. PIUS X: Joseph Sarto was born in 1835, one of eight children in a poor family; his father was a shoe cobbler. He was elected pope in 1903 and took the name Pius X. He had great concern for the everyday lives of the faithful and had a desire to "renew all things in Christ." He was known for his simple and clear, direct homilies, and he encouraged all the faithful to read the Bible, which re-energized biblical studies. Among his lasting contributions to the lives of Catholics: he encouraged frequent reception of Communion.... His decree on the age for first Communion allowed children aged 7 and older to receive the Eucharist; the practice had been reserved for children at least 12 to 14 years old. His will contained one sentence: "I was born poor, I have lived poor, I wish to die poor." The reliquary chapel in the Basilica contains nearly a dozen of his relics, and the museum in the Basilica holds one of his white, papal zucchetos (the small cap worn by bishops).
