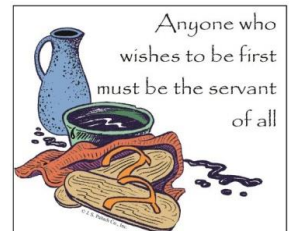

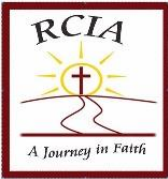

If you or someone you know is interested in joining the church, needs to complete their sacraments of initiation or is a Catholic and just wants to learn more about their faith, this is the place to be.

RCIC – Rite of Christian Initiation of Children: If you have a child over the age of 7 who needs to be baptized, they must go through the RCIC process to receive their sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) at Easter. When you register your child for Faith Formation classes, make sure we are aware they need to be in this class.

RECENT DECREE FROM BISHOP TYSON...

Sunday Obligation

The dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass, which had been set to end on Sunday, September 19, 2021, has been extended to the First Sunday of Advent, **November 28, 2021**, unless a further extension is judged necessary due to the ongoing COVID-19 coronavirus pandemic.

Communion Under Both Species

The reception of the Precious Blood by the Faithful, due to be restored beginning Sunday, September 19, will now be restored on **Easter Sunday, April 17, 2022**.

Facial Coverings

Parishes are to continue following the facial covering guidance issued by the Bishop's Office August 20, 2021, until such time as the state ends the requirement put into place August 19, 2021.

SCOTT HAHN'S REFLECTION ON TODAY'S READINGS...

In today's First Reading, it's like we have our ears pressed to the wall and can hear the murderous grumbings of the elders, chief priests, and scribes—who last week Jesus predicted would torture and kill Him (see [Mark 8:31](#); [10:33-34](#)).

The liturgy invites us to see this passage from the Book of Wisdom as a prophecy of the Lord's Passion. We hear His enemies complain that "the Just One" has challenged their authority, reproached them for breaking the law of Moses, for betraying their training as leaders and teachers.



Today's Gospel and Psalm give us the flip side of the First Reading. In both, we hear of Jesus' sufferings from His point of view. Though His enemies surround Him, He offers Himself freely in sacrifice, trusting that God will sustain Him.

But the Apostles today don't understand this second announcement of Christ's Passion. They begin arguing

over issues of succession—who among them is greatest, who will be chosen to lead after Christ is killed.

Again they are thinking not as God but as human beings (see [Mark 8:33](#)). And again Jesus teaches the Twelve—the chosen leaders of His Church—that they must lead by imitating His example of love and self-sacrifice. They must be "servants of all," especially the weak and the helpless—symbolized by the child He embraces and places in their midst.

This is a lesson for us, too. We must have the mind of Christ, who humbled Himself to come among us (see [Philippians 2:5-11](#)). We must freely offer ourselves, making everything we do a sacrifice in praise of His name.

As James says in today's Epistle, we must seek wisdom from above, desiring humility, not glory, and in all things be gentle and full of mercy.
