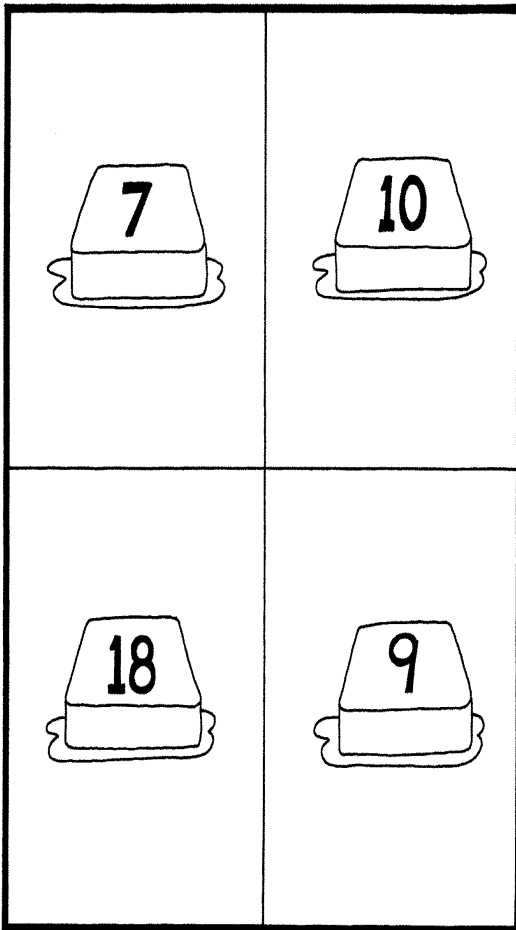
## Twenty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time
