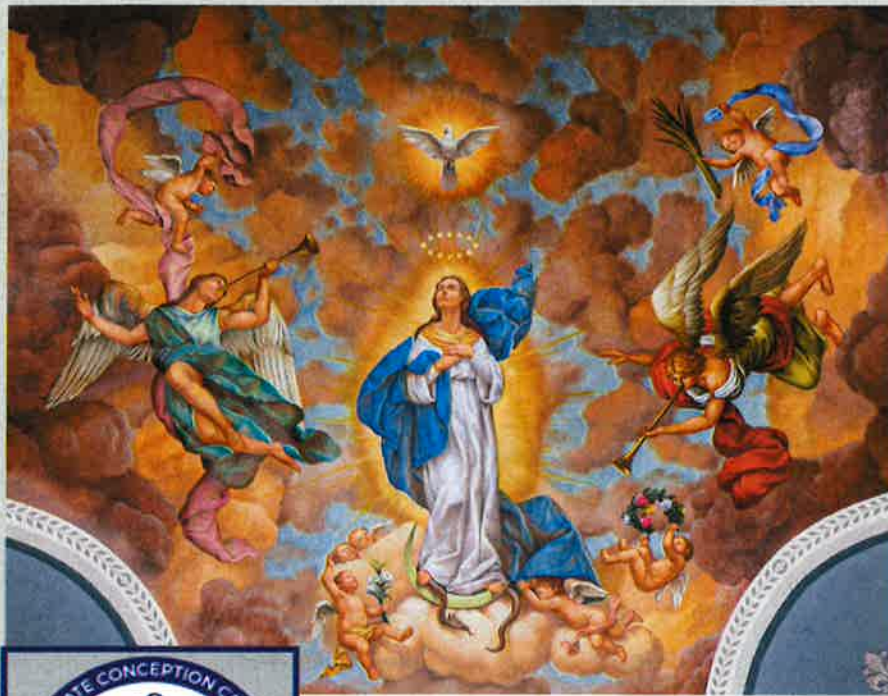

Dear Parishioners,

Three of our Pastoral Council members, elected\* in 2018, namely, Charles Marcantel, Megan McAtee, and Houston Middleton, have completed their three-year term in the Pastoral Council. I would like to thank them for their valuable contribution and generous service to the Cathedral parish. It is now time to vote for new members. Diocesan policy # 219 stipulates the function of the Pastoral Council. It is a consultative body that offers help and advice to the Pastor on matters that affect all parishioners. The body assists the Pastor in determining pastoral priorities based on the needs of the parish. The council meets four times a year, normally on the fourth Tuesday of the months of January, April, July, and October.

Nomination Process

Nominations for Pastoral Council members will be taken until Monday, **October 4, 2021**. There are three positions to be filled for a term of three years.

General qualifications:

- 1) A registered parishioner in good standing with the Church 18 years old or older.
- 2) A desire to serve the parish in the spirit of prayer, study, and cooperation.
- 3) Must follow the precepts of the Church and believe, without reservation, all doctrines of the Catholic Church.

Nominations can be made by self nomination or on behalf of another individual in the following ways:

- 1) At the parish office: 436-7251.
- 2) To one of the nominating committee members: Jimmy Bushnell 540-0566, Grady Conner 405-9204, Nicole Foreman 802-4871, or Houston Middleton 936-0346.
- 3) By placing the nomination in the collection basket on the weekend October 2-3.

Once nominations are received the nominating committee will be tasked with selecting the slate of nominees to be placed on the ballot. The proposed ballot will be submitted to the Pastoral Council for approval.

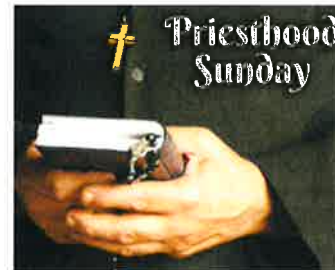
Voting

The nominees will then be voted on by our registered parishioners over the age of 18 at all the Masses on the weekend of **October 30-31**. For those travelling that weekend, early voting will be October 25-29 in the church office. Parishioners may vote only once. The three individuals who receive the highest number of votes will be elected to the Pastoral Council.
