

2020 Health Questionnaire

All St. Denis Employees, Catechists, Children, Parents and Essential Visitors will need to complete a daily health self-check at drop off by answering the questions listed below. We will be taking temperatures before each Religious Education session, prior to entering the building OR being on the parish property. A parent or guardian is responsible for completing the daily screening on behalf of their child(ren). We ask you to review these questions listed below BEFORE coming to Religious Education. This will let you, the parent know, IF your child should attend class OR you should contact our office.

Self-Screening:

Below are the self-screening questions that employees, catechists, parents, children and essential visitors are required to answer daily. If the answers are "NO" to all of the following questions, individuals may enter the building. If you answer YES, please contact the RE office. (Employees, catechists, parents, children and/or essential visitors will be asked questions upon entry & temperature will be taken.)

- Have you been in close or proximate contact in the past 14 days with anyone who has tested positive through a diagnostic test for COVID-19 or who has or had symptoms of COVID-19?
- Have you tested positive through a diagnostic test for COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
- Are you currently experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 including a temperature of greater than 100.0 degrees F in the past 14 days?
- Is your body temperature at or above 100.0 degrees F or have you or your child(ren) taken any temperature reducing drug (ie. Tylenol, Advil, Benadryl, Motrin, Aspirin) within the past 24 hours?
- Have you traveled internationally or from a state with widespread community transmission of COVID-19 per the New York State Travel Advisory in the past 14 days? ([//https://coronavirus.health.ny.gov/covid1-19-travel-advisory](https://coronavirus.health.ny.gov/covid1-19-travel-advisory) for Official State List)

If you YES to any of these questions on any given day, you or your child may NOT enter the Building. Contact a medical professional for guidance and notify the Coordinator of Religious Education. Depending upon the answers to the screening questions, you or your child may need to receive medical clearance to return. If you or your child is sick with a common cold or other ailment not related to COVID-19, stay at home until symptoms subside and you or your child(ren) are fever free without the aid of a temperature reducing drug.
